

This is very simple to make and an excellent way to store/present your inchies.
These matchbook albums can be decorated to match the theme of your inchies.



You will need:

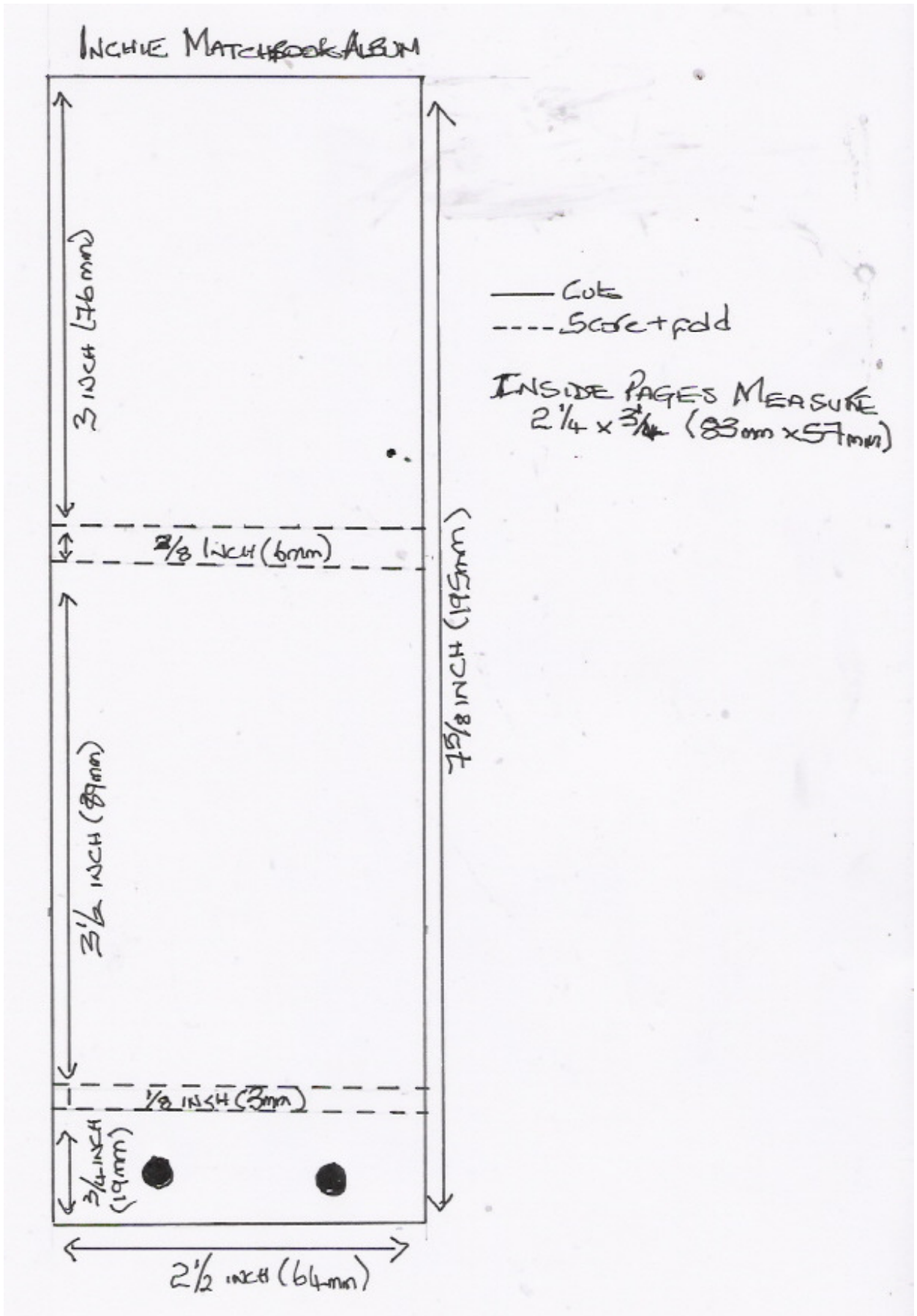
Patterned card (I used scrapbook card that matches the theme)

Plain card to match

Photo corners or photo glue

Ribbon or stapler

Using template below cut out, score and fold the matchbook from a patterned card.



Cut out 3 pages for 9 inchies from a matching card. These should measure 2 1/4 x 3 1/4 inch (83 x 57mm). You don't have to have 3 inches to a page you can also have 2 per page.

Punch Holes through the pages and matchbook and thread ribbon through. Alternatively you can use staples to attach the pages. You can even use the coloured staples.

To attach the inchies to the pages you can use clear photo corners or photo glue. This makes it easy if you ever want to remove the inches without damaging them. As each page is done fold it down to reveal the next page and attach the inches. Do this until all inchies are attached.

To close, tuck the flap into the bottom of the matchbook.

There are so many ways you can decorate these little albums, just let your imagination go wild.

Storage Box



The storage box is made from a cereal packet. For this one I used a microwave porridge oats box. I cut it down to 3 inches high and then cut diagonally from 3 inch down to 1.5 inch. I covered this one with handmade paper and painted the inside with acrylic paint. I then gave it a coat of acrylic matt gel medium. Then added some ribbon.
