- 0.1 The CORK RESTRICTED MINI STAGES RALLY is promoted and organized by the Cork Motor Club Ltd. (hereafter known as the promoters).
- 0.2 The rally is a round the Cork Motor Club Championship. It will take place over a route of approximately 65 stage kilometres with a total of 60 road kilometres.
- 0.3 These Regulations have been submitted to and approved by Motorsport Ireland and the necessary permit for the holding of the Competition has been granted.
- 0.4 PERMIT NO: **08/096**
- 0.5 The official event notice board will be located in the lobby of The Common's Inn, prior to the event starting, and in Donoughmore Community Centre after the event.

ARTICLE 1

- 1.1 The competition will be held under the International Sporting Code of the F.I.A. and the General Competition Rules of the MI including Appendix 25 & 29 and these Supplementary Regulations. All Competitors who forward completed entry form agree to be bound by these rules.

ARTICLE 2

- 2.1. The Supplementary Regulations for the rally are as stated by the Motorsport Ireland 2008 Yearbook, Appendix 25 & 29. Copies of the book are available from Motorsport Ireland Competitions department, 34 Dawson St., Dublin 2.
- 2.2. Final Instructions form an integral part of the Supplementary Instructions.

ARTICLE 3 - Entries

- 3.1. Entries open on publication of the Regulations.

- 3.3 Entry Fee: - €420, including standard IRDS, PA and two tickets to the post event/prize giving barbeque. Additional tickets can be purchased at Documentation Scrutiny.

- 3.6 Maximum number of starters will be 150

 - Best CMC crew.
- 4.2 Additional Awards may be presented
- 4.3 Cork Motor Club Ltd. reserves the right to reduce the number of awards for a class or to amalgamate classes if insufficient entries are received for any class

ARTICLE 5 - Classes

- 5.1 Class 1: Group N cars up to 1400cc
 5.2 Class 2: Group N cars from 1401cc up to 1600cc
 5.3 Class 3: Group N cars from 1601cc up to 2000cc
 5.4 Class 5: Group A cars up to 1400cc
 5.5 Class 6: Group A cars from 1401cc up to 1600cc
 5.6 Class 7: Group A cars from 1601cc up to 2000cc
 5.7 Class 9: Modified Cars, up to 1450cc, normally aspirated and 2 wheel drive only.
 5.8 Class 10: Modified Cars, from 1451cc up to 1650cc, 2 valves per cylinder, normally aspirated and 2 wheel drive only.
 5.9 Class 11: Modified Cars, from 1451cc up to 1650cc, more than 2 valves per cylinder, normally aspirated and 2 wheel drive only.
 5.10 Class 12: Modified Cars, from 1651cc up to 2050cc, 2 valves per cylinder, normally aspirated and 2 wheel drive only.
 5.11 Class 13: Modified Cars, from 1651cc up to 2050cc, more than 2 valves per cylinder, normally aspirated and 2 wheel drive only.
 5.12 Class 16: All Historic cars, pre 1974 cars only.

- 9.1 Pace notes will be allowed on this event.
- 9.2 Recce will take place on Saturday, 7th June, 2008 from 10:00 to 16:00
- 9.3 Motorsport Ireland Regulations regarding illegal reconnaissance (Appendix 29, article 4.6; 4.8 to 4.11) will be enforced and the full penalties will be applied.
- 9.4 Recce will be limited to 3 passes per stage, or part thereof. Penalty for exceeding this will be exclusion.

DECLARATION OF INDEMNITY.

(a) "I have read the Supplementary Regulations issued for this event and agree to be bound by them and by the General Competition Rules of the Royal Irish Automobile Club/Motorsport Ireland. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry or of my being permitted to take part in this event I agree to save harmless and keep indemnified the Cork Motor Club Ltd., the Royal Irish Automobile Club, Motorsport Ireland, Irish Motorsport Federation Ltd., and their respective officials, servants, representatives and agents from and against all actions, claims, costs, expenses and demands in respect of death, injury, loss of or damage to the person or property of myself, my driver(s), passenger(s) or mechanic(s) (as the case may be) howsoever caused arising out of or in connection with this entry or my taking part in this event and notwithstanding that the same may have been contributed to or occasioned by the negligence of the said bodies, their officials, servants, representatives or agents. Furthermore, in respect of any parts of this event on ground where Third Party Insurance is not required by law, this agreement shall in addition to the parties named above extend to all and any other competitor(s) and their servants and agents and to all actions, claims, costs, expenses and demands in respect of loss of or damage to the person or property of myself, my driver(s), passenger(s) or mechanic(s).
