



CYPRESS BAY HOSA MEMBER CONTRACT

Member Obligations

1. Attend general meetings; limit to 4 absences (if absences are due to school related activities documentation will be required for them to be excused)
2. Earn a minimum 30 hours through participation in club activities. If you participate in a community service project, you will also be awarded "service hours" that can be used to meet your graduation requirements.
3. Pay annual dues, field trip, and project fees participate in HOSA yearly fundraiser and sell **the four required car wash presale tickets** on time.
4. Participation in HOSA competitions at the regional level is strongly recommended (state and national levels if qualified)
5. Exhibit good character and have school records free of disciplinary action.

General Meetings

1. General meetings are held twice per month after school (see calendar for dates).
2. A student will receive one hour for each entire general meeting he/she attends. A student who does not attend or who leaves early for another extracurricular event will not receive credit.
3. A student who misses more than four general meetings (excused or unexcused) will be ineligible for a HOSA cord at graduation and/or be ineligible for future HOSA membership.

Graduation Recognition:

HOSA Cords: Senior members in good standing are eligible for a HOSA honor cord. To receive an honor cord, a student must:

- Attain 3.5 or greater GPA in Health Science Classes
- Complete 30 participation hours for each year he/she is in HOSA.
- Complete 80 community service hours by graduation
- Participated in at least 2 HOSA fundraising and 2 community service events during senior year
- Participated in a HOSA Regional Competitive Event
- Be free of Obligations

Consequences:

If any of the following situations occur, students will ineligible for a HOSA cord at graduation and/or be ineligible for future HOSA membership.

- Failure to attend required amount of general meetings.
- "No Showing" at an event previously signed up for.
- Failure to complete a minimum total of 30 participation hours per year.
- Failure to participate in fund-raising.
- Incidents of disciplinary action including (but not limited to) cheating, suspension, or consistent school rules violations.
- Failure to maintain good character (i.e. documented cheating, suspensions, forging of signatures, referrals, and/or general documented misconduct)
