Abasiama's Report from Cameroon

Greetings from Cameroon Missions. Glad to have an opportunity to once again update you with a report of the progress in the work of making disciples for Christ in Africa. It will be a report of a mission work that inspires an enduring hope in the awesome power of the gospel. It is a report that tells the story of the conversion a young man to Christ. It will also scratch the surface of one of the most chronic challenges the missionary is confronted with. October report is a mixture of good and the not- so-good news. Let's get started with soul-winning reports. We did our job of reaching out to save the lost. We preached the truth in love to the teeming population in Limbe.

Thankfully, we had one soul who was baptized into Christ. The young man's name is Thierry. His actual immersion pictures were not available at the time of putting together the contents of this report. The only picture is the one he stood with me in front of the church just minutes away from his baptism. We thank God for his salvation which finally



came after many occasions of "let me think about it first" kind of response to our preaching. There are countless others to whom our gospel had reached but they are still in the desolate valley of procrastination. We pray that one day, and hopefully soon, they may come to the place of absolute

surrender to the One who truly loves them.

In a contrasting addition to the good news of Thierry's conversion, is the discouraging news of the stalling of work on the church building. Why, and who is responsible, you may want to enquire? It is the Limbe City Council (LCC) that came to the church building and marked a notice of "STOP WORK, SEE LCC". The church is definitely concerned about this order by the LCC demanding us to stop the building work until we have paid some more money to the council which we are not even supposed to pay. However, we have gathered some additional building material to resume work as soon as the ban is lifted by the LCC.



In another development, I want to sorrowfully relate to you the sad news of my son's diagnosis of genetic defect in his red blood cells. About four years ago we tested him to know his status regarding Sickle Cell Anemia. The result then was negative. October this year, he was severely anaemic and another test was conducted. This time, the result was positive. I have donated blood three times to my son in his seven years of existence. His health condition has been very horrifying because of incessant illness that always demands blood transfusion. It was in October this year that we discovered very unpleasantly that my son, my only son whom I love, is an SS. Brethren I have suffered with this child for seven years without knowing what was wrong with him. I have spent

time and money every month in the hospital all these years but to no avail. The first test result was incorrect because of the outdated medical equipment used the electrophoresis. Our health centers here are not reliable. Please pray for my son who just celebrated his 7th anniversary last August. And please, if you know of any medical possibility to correct this genetic disorder, kindly inform us. For now, the situation of my son seems to be my greatest challenge in Cameroon. Hardly a month would pass by without an admission in a pediatric ward. Please help me with information, counsel and direction from experts on what to do. I have tried all I could but I am stranded with Providence who life had been truly providential. I live constantly with the threat of losing him. Please help me in any way you can.

And let me once again thank you for the help you have been rendering to me spiritually and financially since I started this work 10 years ago. You all have been of incredible assistance to the work of the kingdom of God in Cameroon. I will always thank God for the faith you repose in this mission. Your supportive efforts have accomplished so much so far. You started supporting this work even before my time. The longevity of your partnership is not taken for granted because we know it has not been so easy with you also over there.

Finally, my brethren please pray for the nation of Cameroon. We are now living in fear of a possible outbreak of war. The country has been under political tension all these years until recently things have begun to fall apart. Soldiers are now stationed on the streets of Limbe as the apprehension generated by the strike action of lawyers and teachers reaches a boiling point. My kids cannot go to again until further notice. One man has ruled Cameroon since 1982 till today. The country is deeply divided between the Francophones and the Anglophones. The shadow of armed conflict is clearly in the horizon. Only God can ward off this looming danger. Only time will tell.
