June, July and August is vacation time and of course several of families and members are on vacation. Some went back to their homeland and other traveled to Spain, Portugal and other countries of Europe, so therefore our worship attendance has been down like it's every summer.

The first baptism we had was a website contact Antoine Tshibanda. He took a BCC with me and decided to be baptized for the remission of his sins! I gave him the information about the church in his area in Congo RDC and he was baptized by a brother there on June 9<sup>th</sup>. Since that time he is continuing faithfully to study with me by email.

After many weeks of study with Rojamie Varona, I baptized he and his daughter who had also studied with Rose on August the 6<sup>th</sup>! Astrid and her Dad are from the Philippines.

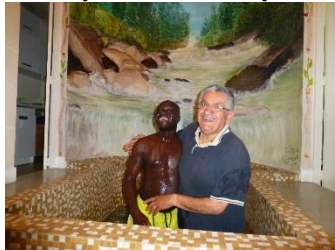
The two other baptisms were on Saturday September 2<sup>nd</sup>. Francis Tetthey from Ghana and one Sunday night after my Bible class, Simon Ricardo a young men 19 years old from Haiti. To God be the glory for these new brothers and sisters in Christ.



The five new contacts are Jean Jacques and Philomena his wife, from the Ivory Coast. He called one day and say your church is never opened between noon and two a clock, because he was looking for a place where he could read his Bible and pray and did not want to go to a Catholic building. I told him the hours we were opened and told him

that if he was interested to study no problem I would make myself available for him. The very next day he called and we had a Bible study together and he liked it so well that the very next day he continued to come to study. Since then, he and his wife are coming every Saturday to study English with Rose and afterward I have a Bible study with both of them. He is Catholic and his wife from the Assembly of God. It's my prayers that we will be able to lead them to obey the gospel.

Tracy Therese a 27 years old young woman working in a research lab contacted us after visiting our website. She called and asked a few questions about the Church and the following Sunday she came to Bible class and worship. I offered to study the Bible with her and she accepted and I also offered her a BCC which she agreed to take! Right now she is on her 4<sup>th</sup> lesson.



Sophie a French Lady who lives in our neighborhood showed up at the building 3 Sundays ago and says that she looked for a place for worship since where she went was closed during the month of August so she found us and liked it so much that she will continue to come. After worship we invited her to eat with us and also Rachel Taitt parents who visited their daughter from Trinidad. After the meal we sang church hymns and Sophie told us that she did not know much about the Bible and would like to study with us.

Wahiba, the wife of the contractor who did the work on our building, is continuing her study of the Bible and she expressed the fact that she would like to come and assist at one of our Sunday morning worship services.

Rachel T, after receiving her master's degree, moved to Lyon, France to work on her doctor's degree. We sure going to miss her. Enyo Assouklo moved to the states to attend Sunset International Bible institute for a two year training in Bible knowledge. After she will go back to Togo, Africa to work with the ladies of the congregation. We know that it will be a challenge for her, but she has perseverance and is determined to finish the two year program. I shipped to Enyo's brother who is an Evangelist back in Togo, 75 boxes of French teaching material and tracts for the church and contacts there!

In the past three months more than 1,500 brochures and tracts was taken from here, by members, visitors, and people from the street. Because of the website several people have visited us. From the website we get each month an average of more than 5000 visitors and from around 90 different nations.



By the time you receive this newsletter we will be in the States for a short visit from September 12<sup>th</sup> till October 3<sup>rd</sup> so Rose get her driver license and other papers. All of this because Isis we can no longer have any official papers done in France. We will also take advantage to have dental work done, since in France dentist want \$1500 to \$1700 just for a lower plate and up to \$4000 for a full set of teeth. Once we come back Rose and I we will be flying on the 10<sup>th</sup> to Canada to inaugurate the new building of the Lord's Church in Lake St John, where Brother

Jean Grenier and his family started that work there 10 years ago. I will also be preparing the inauguration dinner. I must say that I am honored that John asked me to participate to this event. I also will be sharing God's Word while there.

We want to thank every one of you that are praying for us and the French work. Even though Europe has become more and more unstable because of all the terrorist attacks, we feel safe and are staying away from tourist attraction places and well known church buildings.

We are indeed appreciative for your continual partnership in spreading the Gospel.
