Try Out To Win A Prestigious World Math Contest:

If any student (**born after 9/1/93**, and attends **7th grade or lower**) enjoys solving math problems, he/she is invited to tryout for the **USA-Silicon Valley** teams to compete in an International Math Contest in Hong Kong in July 2007. It is a unique opportunity for the Elementary and Junior High students to have both, an academic and a cultural experience, with children from around the World. Team participation is by invitation only and each country is entitled to send a team consisting of 4 students. Last year 48 teams and about 200 students from countries across the globe participated.



Having participated only in the past 2 years, the **USA-Silicon Valley** teams have already won a total of Ten Honorable awards - an incredible accomplishment in such a prestigious competition!

Qualify For A Trip to Hong Kong:

To qualify for the teams, the students must take a **tryout test administered by MathEdge, consisting of 20 non multiple-choice word problems lasting for duration of 45 minutes without a calculator.** Based on the tryout results, the top10% students will be invited to go through an 8-week training period offered by **MathEdge**. Another test will be administered to select the final 4 to 8 students for the final training lasting until June. For the final selected students, **all expenses in Hong Kong for five days including room, board, and local tours will be covered.** However, the student is responsible for his/her airfare, training costs, and other expenses.

In addition, top 10 students will be awarded a "Math Wizard" trophy.

Parents will be notified of the tryout results through email within 2 weeks after administering the test. The student **must provide at least one parent's email address, along with the student's date of birth, and grade level.**
