The cost of this wine was \$6.99. What a bargain! After the tasting we went to Carmel Café & Wine Bar for dinner. **Next tasting is Thursday, April 21st at Donna Schaeffer's home.**



Wine Group 2 tasting was held on Monday, March 21 at the home of Stan and Terri Holsinger. 11 of us had a great evening tasting Malbec. Stan read the description of each wine as we tried them. It was fun to try to figure out if we could taste what was described. We also learned that Malbecs are almost exclusively from Argentina. We had no idea. We did find 2 from France and 1 from Chile and 3 from Argentina. We had a tie for #1 Cruz Alta Malbec Reserve \$15 from Mendoza, Argentina and D'Autrefois Malbec from South of France (least expensive at \$11). Most expensive at \$25 came in 3rd. Everyone enjoyed the new restaurant in UTC area, The Rusty Bucket, where we had a private room and the best server we've ever experienced. **The next tasting is Monday, April 18 at Peggy and Hal Hayden's.**
