OUR LORD

O LORD our Lord, how excellent is thy name in all the earth! who hast set thy glory above the heavens (Psalm 8:1).

The word **excellent** in Hebrew means *wide* or *large*. It is used figuratively in reference to powerful. It also conveys the thought of gallant, glorious, goodly, noble, and worthy. In reference to the Lord Jesus Christ, we are told, *Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved* (Acts 4:12). The Psalmist concluded, *For I know that the LORD is great, and that our Lord is above all gods* (Psalm 135:5). Here the word **LORD** refers to the *self-existent* or *eternal* Jehovah.

In warning the early New Testament Christians of false prophets and teachers, the Apostle Peter reveals that our Lord Jesus bought us our freedom from the penalty of sin (2 Peter 2:1). He did this through *...His own blood...having obtained eternal redemption for us* (Hebrews 9:12). In connection with the needful harvest of sinners for the kingdom of God, the Apostle Matthew records Jesus saying to the disciples, *The harvest truly is plenteous, but the labourers are few; Pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he will send forth labourers into his harvest.* (Matthew 9:37-38).

Once we have received or asked Jesus into our heart to save us (Romans 10:13), the Apostle Paul tells us that Christ wants to be the Lord of our sacrifice (our service): *I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service* (Romans 12:1). He goes on to share with us in the next verse, *And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God* (vs.2). We do this by allowing the mind of Christ (Bible thinking) to be in us. *Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus* (Philippians 2:5).

Great is our Lord, and of great power: his understanding is infinite (Psalm 147:5). Jesus Christ is our **great** Lord, referred to in the Bible. Let us examine ourselves: Do we have a good relationship with the Lord of our salvation and our service? We all bow to some lord in our life. Who is the lord in our life? As Christians, let us bow to the Lord Jesus Christ. Let us make Him the Lord of our life.

The Sacrificial Love of God

I John 3:1-10

Message by *Dr. Caswell A. Reeves*

The love of the Father is a sacrificial love that sent His only begotten Son that whosoever believes on Him has great eternal benefits. Here are some of those benefits:



- I. The sacrificial love of God makes us the children of God (vs. 1)
- II. The sacrificial love of God separates us from the world (vs. 1)
- III. The sacrificial love of God gives us hope (vs. 2)
- IV. The sacrificial love of God makes us pure/righteous (vs. 5)
- V. The sacrificial love of God gives us power over sin (vs. 8-9)
- VI. The sacrificial love of God identifies us as separate from the devil's crowd (vs. 10)

The sacrificial love of the Father is His Son Jesus Christ. If you have the Son, you have eternal life and all its benefits. Have you repented and received Jesus Christ as your Savior?
