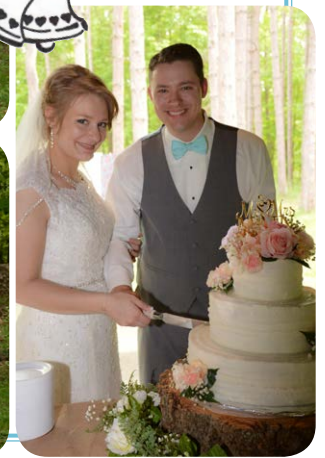
THIS WEEK:

ONE WORD: "SAVED"

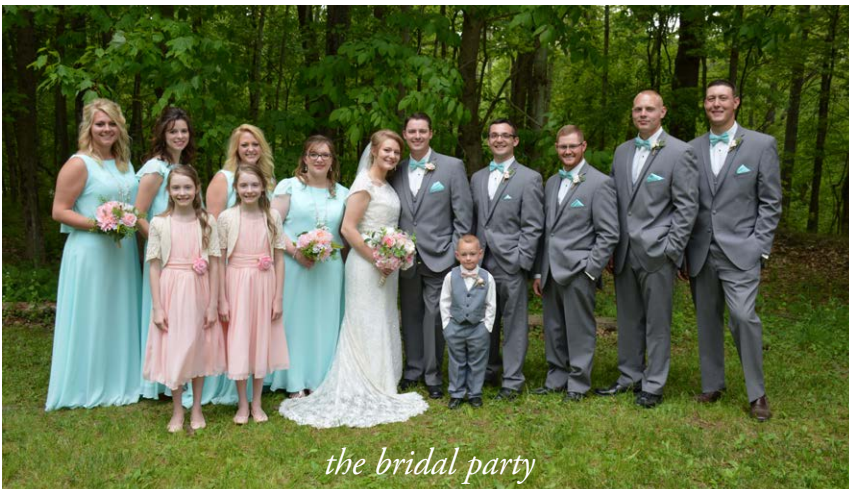
Jesus said, "...*these things I say, that ye might be saved*" (John 5:34).

This is a personal testimony. I give thanks for one word. It was the word *saved*. Out of all the words in the Bible, it was that one word, *saved*, that the Holy Spirit of God used in my life to convict me of my unsaved or lost state as a sinful man before a holy God. I first heard the word *saved* when a Baptist preacher and his wife, while visiting in my home sharing the Gospel, asked me if I was *saved*. After that, others who went to his church continually asked me if I was *saved*.

Those who spoke with me all spoke with a confidence that they were *saved* and knew it, because the Bible told them so. I did not have such confidence. I did not know if I was *saved* and going to heaven. The LORD continued to convict me. He worked in my heart. Eventually, I went to see that Baptist Preacher. I asked him to show me from the Bible how I could be *saved* and know it. Two of many verses he showed me were: *That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.* And then, *For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.* (Romans 10:9,13).

I saw the word *saved* in both of those verses. And then, believing with all of my heart in Jesus Christ, I called upon Him in prayer to *save* me. You know, He promised me He would, and He did - *save* me. And today, I can say confidently, based upon God's Word and promise, *I am saved*. The Apostle John said, *These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know (present tense - right now) that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God* (1 John 5:13).

Message by *Dr. Caswell A. Reeves*

You don't have to be a spiritual pygmy. There are four keys or four gifts that God has given to His children so that they might be successful.



- I. Believe what God says
 - A. It is the key to getting saved (John 3:16,18,36)
 - B. It is the key to pleasing God (Hebrews 11:5)
- II. Obey what God says
 - A. It is the demonstration of our love (John 14:21)
 - B. It is more important than sacrifice (1 Samuel 15:22)
- III. Ask God when you need something
 - A. It is the key to joy (John 16:24)
 - B. It is how we get things (James 4:2)
 - C. It is the way we glorify God (John 14:13)
 - D. It is the revealing of our relationship (John 15:7)
- IV. Tell others what God is doing
 - A. It is what the redeemed do (Psalm 107:2)
 - B. House to house (Acts 20:20)

When you avail yourself of these keys which the Lord has given for His children's spiritual growth, then you will be successful in your spiritual life.
