-I have been DOM for the Gibson Baptist Association 5 years (since July 1999). Prior to coming to Gibson Assn. Kathy and I were IMB missionaries to Eastern Europe, living in Bucharest, Romania. The first two years of IMB service I was pastor of the International Baptist Church of Bucharest. Then for the next 4 years I was Mission Administrator for the Central Europe Mission (Romania, Hungary, Slovakia, Czech Republic, & Poland). Prior to our IMB service, I served as pastor of the Green River Baptist Church in Waynesboro (8 years).

As DOM for GBA I have led our association to enter into several Acts 1:8 partnership initiatives. We will complete at the end of this year, a 4 year partnership with Bucharest Baptist Association and the IMB. We have been working with our missionaries who are working to evangelize and plant churches among the Gypsies of Romania. We have sent 24 teams and involved more than 200 GBA volunteers in these projects. We are currently working to form a new partnership with our IMB missionaries in Oaxaca, Mexico. We are also completing our 3 year of partnership with the Central Baptist Association of Michigan (Jackson & Lansing area), and we will be extending next year for the fourth year. Our association also has a partnership with Mississippi River Ministries of Tennessee, Birth Choice of Gibson County, and Christian Women's Job Corps of Gibson County.
