Both sire and dam must be ADBA registered, have a registered name on file and ownership recorded in the current owner's name, before the litter will be registered. If the required information is not listed on the front of dogs registration certificate then, (1) a transfer of ownership is needed on sire and/or dam, or (2) dogs registered name needs to be recorded with the ADBA registration office. **Be sure to mail all forms together to expedite registration procedures.** If sire, dam or both are not registered with the ADBA, you must apply for registration with a **single registration application**, before research can begin. (Complete three generation pedigree is required.) **Be sure to mail all forms together.** We must process the paperwork (of sire, dam or both) **before we can process the litter.** Completed registrations will then be sent to appropriate owner(s). **If paperwork is to be sent to a third party, written permission must be given.** ONLY LIVE PUPPIES ARE TO BE REGISTERED. *Be sure to verify litter application information, as pups not listed on litter application will be considered dead.* PUPS OVER ONE YEAR OF AGE CANNOT BE REGISTERED AS A LITTER. THEY MUST BE REGISTERED ON A SINGLE REGISTRATION APPLICATION. Any litter produced by a sire and/or dam less than nine months of age at the birth of the litter and/or over 11 yrs old at the time of breeding, you are required to provide additional verification. Sire: A DNA profile is required. Dam: Attach a photo of the bitch with the pups, and/or a DNA profile. Litters resulting from use of frozen semen must be accompanied by form AIFS. Use of cooled semen, must use form FRCS. **All applications are available for printing on our website at www.adba.cc.**

When listing the colors of your pups, please list the most dominant color first, the second dominant color second, etc. If the dog has white or black markings, list to basic color, (*Example white marks, or black marks.*) It is assumed that the nose color is black, unless listed otherwise. (*Example: red/red nose*) - Or, there may be a gray nose in the case of a blue dog. (*Example: blue/gray nose*)

ACCEPTED TERMS TO DESCRIBE COLORS

Black - jet black to dull black.

Black and Tan - predominantly black with tan markings over eyes, muzzle, chest, feet, and legs. May also have white markings.

Blue - any shade of blue gray to gray blue from deep slate to light blue gray usually with a gray nose.

Bluies - portions of coat having a distinct blue or gray cast. This is often associated with lighter or blue eyes. A reddish or gray pigment around the eye rims, nose, and lips are also identified with this color. To indicate this coloring please list the predominant color first/bluies/markings, etc.

Brindle - a striped pattern of brown with black hairs over lighter colored coat or a striped pattern of lighter colored hairs over a darker colored coat. Please list underlying coat color first, then brindle. i.e.: fawn brindle, black brindle, etc.

Brown -

Buckskin - tan with yellow tones

Chocolate - can range from a dark chocolate to a light milk chocolate

Chocolate and Tan - predominantly chocolate with tan markings over eyes, muzzle, chest, feet, and legs. May also have white markings.

Dark fawn - brown with red tones

Fawn - tan with red tones

Gray - can be listed as light or dark

Liver - deep brown with red tones.

Red - can be listed as light or dark

Red and Tan - predominantly red with tan markings over eyes, muzzle, chest, feet, and legs. May also have white markings

Seal - appears black except has red or brown cast when viewed in sun or bright light.

Tan - a light beige.

Ticked - darker hairs distributed in a diffuse pattern over a lighter colored coat. List the predominate color first, then black or brown ticked.

White -

UNACCEPTED TERMS TO DESCRIBE COLORS

Amber - list as buckskin

Apricot - list as light red

Beige - list as tan

Blonde - list as buckskin

Blue fawn - list as fawn bluies

Bronze - list as red/brown

Champagne - list as light fawn

Cherry - list as dark red

Cinnamon - list as light red

Cocoa - list as chocolate

Copper - list as red

Creme - list as light tan

Dudley nose - flesh colored nose. List as red nose.

Foxy - list as fawn

Gold - list as dark buckskin

Mahogany - list as deep brown with red tones, or list as liver

Orange - list as light red

Pied - comparatively large patches of two or more colors or parti-colored. List as patched with the predominate color first.

Rust - list as dark red

Sable - deep brown with gray, black or red tones. List as dark brown and then add color of tones.

Silver - list as gray

Tri-colored - dominant color with tan markings (*Doberman like markings*). List as black and tan/ white markings.

Yellow - list as buckskin

These color descriptions are to be used for identification purposes only and are not intended to specify genetic make up or bloodlines.
