TRANSPORTATION AGREEMENT & CONTRACT FOR SERVICES

This contract is herein entered into upon this _____ day of _____ in the year 2007. This contract shall be between Garrett Transportation, herein after referred to as GT, and _____ hereinafter referred to as CLIENT.

It is understood that transportation to and from school shall be provided, at designated times and locations as noted in Article A, and that in compensation for said services, CLIENT agrees to pay GT the monthly payment as indicated below for the school year 2007-2008. To begin AUGUST 17, 2007, and end May 30, 2008. CLIENT understands that there is no pro-rata of payments or refunds. Client agrees to make 10 equal monthly installments, as indicated in "fee section".

INITIAL

FUEL SURCHARGE SECTION - CLIENT further agrees that for every increase of \$0.10 in diesel fuel price in Cameron Park, Ca., with a base price of \$3.09 per gallon of no. 2 diesel, that a fuel surcharge of 10% increase in fees will be added to CLIENT per month (\$17.50 for two-way pass, and, \$11.00 for one-way pass), and will be billed each calendar month. Client shall pay all remaining surcharges on the last month of service at the end of the month.

CLIENT shall pay a late charge of 10% for late fuel surcharge payments, which may be caused by, but not limited to, an invalid or unprocessable credit card that GT has on file, as contained herein.

CLIENT UNDERSTANDS THAT THIS CONTRACT IS CANCELABLE WITH 30 DAYS WRITTEN NOTICE BY EITHER PARTY, AND THAT IN THE EVENT THAT TRANSPORTATION SERVICES ARE NO LONGER DESIRED, WANTED, OR USED BY CLIENT, THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS OR PRO-RATA OF FEES WHATSOEVER, AND THAT FAILURE TO USE TRANSPORTATION SERVICES DOES NOT NEGATE CLIENTS RESPONSIBILITY TO PAY FOR CONTRACTED SERVICES CONTAINED HEREIN, THAT CLIENT HAS AGREED TO.

Client also understands that transportation services will be denied for any students whom GT has not received payment of fees, which include monthly payments or fuel surcharges, for any given month for which they are due, and such denial of transportation shall not be notified in advance from GT to Client.

Client further understands that cancellation of services in writing forfeits transportation at the conclusion of paid service term, and that if Client wishes to re-enroll for bus service at a later date, there will be a \$50 registration fee. The registration fee will be due each time Client cancels contract and renews such contract. Client is not guaranteed a seat upon renewal, but as there is availability on the bus.

GT AGREES TO:

- A. Provide reliable, safe transportation, with vehicles certified by the proper authority, as required by law in the state of California.
- B. Provide a regular route schedule of arrival and departure (Article A), as provided herein.
- C. Provide backup transportation in case of an emergency or bus break-down.
- D. Comply and abide by all state and federal laws, rules and regulations pertaining to carrier transportation.
- E. Provide certified drivers trained in the industry of transportation.
- F. To not leave any bus stop in the A.M. according to the schedule (Article A) contained herein.
- G. Set time according to pacific national standard time as found by dialing "popcorn" (767-2676) on the telephone.

Note: All students must arrive 5 minutes early in the AM to the bus stop. Bus will not wait for students to arrive, as it is necessary to keep all the stop times accurate, and offset any possible traffic delays.

Traffic delays unforeseen by GT may necessitate a different stop time, or route for both AM and PM routes. Any delays will be notified to the GT terminal and parents may call (530) 677-4990 for an update. If there are any AM delays in traffic, or any other reason that will make student late for school the schools will be notified of such, and an approximate time of arrival.

NOTE: GT may find it necessary to adjust the above times to be more punctual to school on time as dictated by traffic conditions. Times may also adjust at each stop sight to more accurately reflect arrival and departure times, as also dictated by traffic conditions. Students will receive written notice as to any changes of stop and arrival times.

Incident Report Involving Transportation

The following is a list of infractions for which a citation may be issued. Normally, unless determined by the driver as more severe, students will receive at least one warning involving an infraction before getting a written citation. If repeated infractions occur on a regular basis, verbal warnings will not be issued any longer.

PENALTIES

1st Citation	Warning; unless the judgement of the department, the penalty should be more severe.
2nd Citation	Loss of transportation for two (2) school days
3rd Citation	Loss of transportation for two (2) weeks
4th Citation	Loss of transportation privileges for the balance of the school year

One method used to help correct, is to move student to a different seat, so as to avoid a citation if possible. The policy of the department is to not issue citations unless it is necessary to correct infraction violations. We encourage parents to work with GT in discussing infractions and help remedy the problem.

TRANSPORTATION RULES

The driver has complete authority in operating the vehicle at all times. If, for any reason, a driver determines that a person's behavior is creating an unsafe situation on the vehicle, the transportation department has the authority to deny transportation privileges.

1. Students shall be under the authority of, and directly accountable to the driver.
2. All students should be at their designated bus stop at least 5 minutes before the scheduled time of pick-up.
3. Students must remain seated in the vehicle while it is in motion.
4. All students must remain seated and quiet at all railroad crossings.
5. Students are to remain orderly and in control while the driver is out of the vehicle.
6. Playing music, or noise in excess of acceptable levels is prohibited.
7. Throwing, shooting, scuffing, or other distracting commotion is not permitted.
8. EATING, DRINKING, AND CHEWING GUM IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED ABOARD VEHICLE.
9. While on/in the vehicle no part of a student's body shall be out the window. At no time shall any student throw anything out the window.
10. Animals, including reptiles, and insects may not be transported on the vehicle.
11. No hazardous materials may be transported on the vehicle, as deemed hazardous by the driver.
12. No discharging of perfumes, colognes, or other gases that may be allergic, or offensive to other passengers.
13. No student may damage or interfere with another student or property.
14. Any damage to the vehicle by a student which cannot be considered ordinary wear and tear must be paid for by student OR responsible party causing damage.
15. No students may hinder another from leaving or entering vehicle such as; seated, aisles, etc...
16. All students must keep the aisle way clear of property, and their bodies, and feet must not be placed on seats or armrests.
17. Students must observe proper seating positions, and may not sit facing the rear of the vehicle, and must be seated on the seat at all times.
18. Absolutely no profanity in language, gesture, or music is permitted at any time, and is subject to driver's discretion.
19. No intimate contact allowed on the vehicle between riders. This includes, but is not limited to; kissing, cuddling, touching private areas, or areas considered by the driver to be inappropriate, sitting on the lap of another, placing legs or arms across another. The driver shall have final authority over this type of behavior. Failure to comply will result in separation, and citations as they apply.

I have read and understand the above rules. I agree to instruct my son/daughter to follow them and understand that I or my son/daughter may incur penalties, fines or disciplinary actions if my son/daughter breaks an above rule(s).

Medical Treatment Authorization

My child, has permission to ride the bus provided by Garrett Transportation. If, in the opinion of the bus driver that a medical condition, or need occurs either on the bus, or at a bus stop where driver is responsible during boarding and disembarking the bus, then, said bus driver shall have authorization and authority to consent on behalf of my child, or myself the following medical treatment:

Any X-ray examination, anesthetic, medical or surgical diagnosis or treatment, and hospital care which is deemed advisable by, and is to be rendered under the general or special supervision of any physician and/or surgeon licensed under the provisions of the Medical Practices Act, California and Business Professionals Code section 2000 et seq.; or any X-ray examination, anesthetic, dental or surgical diagnosis or treatment, and hospital care to be rendered by a dentist licensed under the provisions of the Dental Practices Act, California Business and Professions Code section 1600 et seq.

This authorization shall remain in effect for the duration of this contract, or as long as my child rides Garrett Transportation Buses, unless revoked in writing. I understand that as a parent/legal guardian, I will be responsible for the cost of any service or treatment provided.
