Need an MSOA Paint Kit?

Send your order to Guin at guinatsalemmsoa@gmail.com. Art supply prices are going up, and we want to do everything possible to keep the cost at the lowest price possible. The paint kits are \$45.00, this includes paints and brushes. Brush Sets are \$15.00 which includes, a fan brush, round brush, flat brush, fluffy brush and detail brush. If you purchase brushes on your own, be careful not to pick up watercolor soft brushes. You do not have to purchase paint kits through the school. Check our Class Descriptions page for a list of colors needed. Use your Michael coupons, other art stores to get the best price. Be careful about off brands that contain more water than pigment.

Watercolor Supplies

This term, if you need watercolor class supplies we are doing something different to help you keep costs down. If you need watercolor paint, we will supply it for \$5 for the term or we can supply watercolor paint and paper for just \$8 for the term. 2 items the students will need (and can both be found at Michaels) are a round watercolor palette and a watercolor brush size round 8 or 10 (no Artists Loft brushes).

Creative Writing, Figure Drawing and Watercolor Instructor

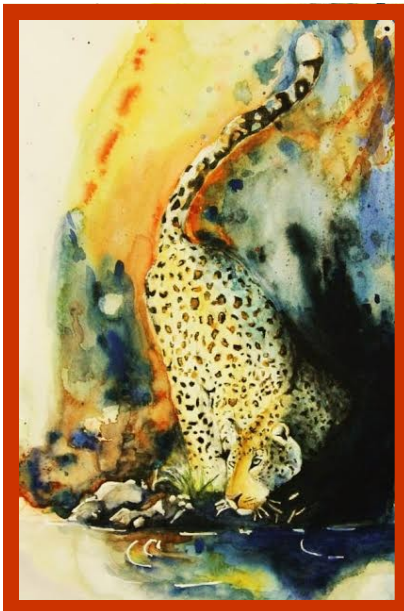
