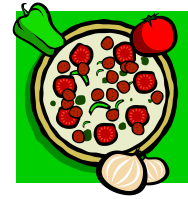


Crazy Day! The Day Art School Goes a Little Crazy!

Next Parent Meeting

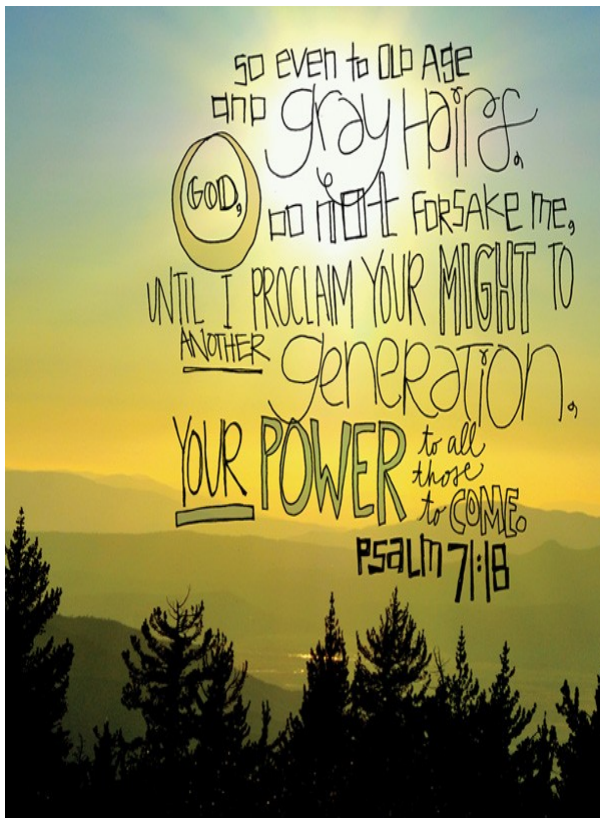
Our next parent meeting will be on Monday, November 4th right after school. Our main topic will be crazy day and our upcoming art exhibit.
