Last Chance to Order Paint Kits

Art supply prices are going up, and we want to do everything possible to keep the cost the lowest possible.

The paint kits are \$42.00, this includes paints and brushes. Brush Sets are \$15.00 which includes, a fan brush, round brush, flat brush, fluffy brush and detail brush.

If you purchase brushes on your own, be careful not to pick up watercolor soft

brushes. You do not have to purchase paint kits through the school. Use your Michaels coupons, Blicks or other art stores to get the best price. Be careful of brands that contain more water than pigment.

We must have orders as soon as possible. These can be paid for during our orientation on Wednesday, August 28th. We will try to have the kits by our first day of class on September 9th.

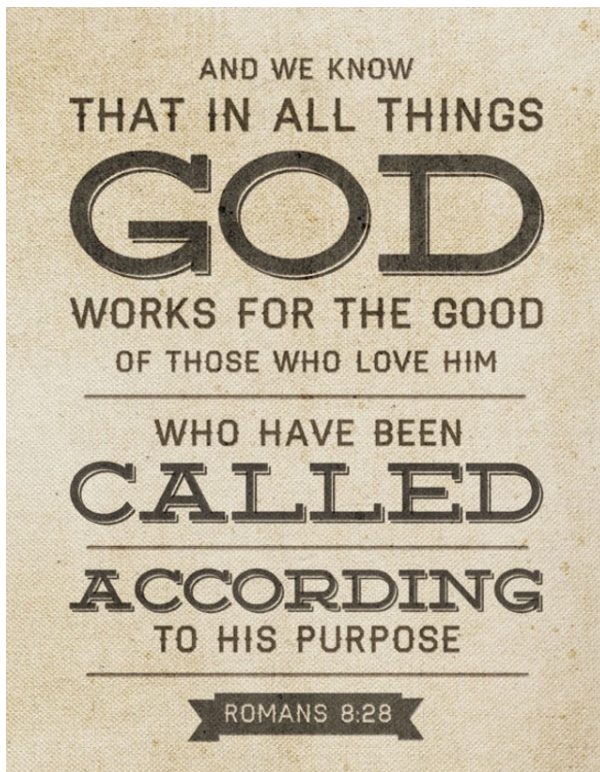
