

Updates to OSTPA 2013 Rulebook in Effect for the 2016 Season



Passed November 2015

1. Executive Board - Any competition vehicle with fireshow may only use the fireshow while hooked to sled and all persons are a safe distance away. A violation could result in disqualification.
2. NC Club - Section V. General Rules - All Divisions, Section B. - Chassis, Sub-section 5 part c. states "Front axles on all tractors must be mounted rigid to frame or on rigid pivot. No air bags or other suspension on front axle." Remove this rule, and add "Front axle suspension to be allowed on all tractors; If air bags are being used, only one location to be used for air operation, and cannot be accessible from the operators platform."
3. RTNT Club – OSTPA to adopt PPL diesel fuel testing limits. 30-100 on dialectic meter.
4. Executive Board - At a Grand Ohio level event, Super Stock class will allow PPL Unlimited Super Stock rules to compete in our Super Stock class. All Super Stock Tractors that pull at that event and are competing members of OSTPA and PPL will receive 40 points.
5. RTNT Club – Limited Pro Stock Tractors to use PPL turbo rule.
6. Semi Division – Maximum tire size 11r24.5. Maximum overall tread width 10 inches. Maximum wheel width to be 8.25 inches.
7. Semi Division – OEM highway semi truck electronically controlled engines allowed in semi class. Must use system that came on semi truck. Electronic engine must use factory ECM with factory connections. All electronic engine control must come from OE ECM. ECM must have a connection for tech department to connect scanner to verify factory ECM is controlling engine before and during pull. No crossing of parts. A Cummins engine must have a Cummins ECM and fuel system, a Cat must use a Cat system, etc. OE fuel system parts only. NO traction control allowed. No driveline speed sensors connected to ECM. If data logger has a driveline sensor it cannot be connected to ECM. Single turbo only.
8. 2.6 Division – Allow one year to adopt to new/proposed PPL rules. Allow 2.6 map groove or 3.0 smooth bore turbo. Allow factory wheel base with OEM driveline. If not OEM driveline, then must have 158" wheel base.
9. Executive Board - _ Redistribute the purse. See table below. All classes would move to this payout.

Updates to OSTPA 2013 Rulebook in Effect for the 2015 Season

Passed November 2014

1. TWD division – In TWD class, have a maximum of 4 wheels in contact with the pulling surface.
2. TWD division – No adjustable suspension on TWD vehicle capable of changing rear drawbar height.
3. RTNT Club - OSTPA to offer 2.6 Diesel 4x4 Pickups. Use PPL rules. Purse to be the same as other OSTPA classes. Points to be same as other classes.

Passed April 2015

1. RTNT Club - For OSTPA fuel or water rule violations to be as follows: 1st offense - no money or points at that event, 2nd offense - suspension of driver and vehicle for 1 year and 10 days.

Updates to OSTPA 2013 Rulebook in Effect for the 2014 Season

Passed November 2013

1. SS Division – Alcohol V-8 tractors with aftermarket head to run 18 inch drawbar at 7500 lb.
2. SS Division - All Super Stock alcohol, 6 cylinder tractors with push rod, aftermarket head engines to run 19 inch drawbar at 8,000 lb.

Passed April 2014

1. Super Stock Class – SS Class to allow 504 cubic inch or smaller alcohol powered tractors with after-market push rod heads to run at 20” drawbar height at 8,000 lbs.
2. Executive Board – Remove rule under Super Stock, p. 14-L-2, Super Farm tractors are allowed to compete, under their own rules and regulations (excluding weight), in the Super Stock Class. Remove rule p. 17-B- Super Farm tractors are allowed to compete, under their own divisional rules and regulations (excluding weight) in Pro Stock or Super Stock classes.
