## Principal's Report - Irfan Shiek

Consultation with stakeholders and the public regarding the 2014/2015 Preliminary Budget Proposal occurs as follows:

- April 14, 2014 to obtain input from VBE stakeholders
- April 15, 2014 to obtain input from the general public
- April 28, 2014 to obtain input from the general public and VBE stakeholders on the Revised Budget Proposals

The Board of Trustees will make their final deliberations and adopt the 2014/2015 Preliminary Operating Budget on April 30, 2014.

Draft calendar is out which includes a 4 day weekend in November. There is still a 2 week spring break. Everything else remains the same.

The Ministry of Education has revised the June 2014 Provincial Examination schedule and moved two exams later into the month as there was a concern about not meeting the instructional minutes. The changes affect the English 10 and Social Studies 11 Provincial Examinations. Parents and students should make note of these changes before finalizing end of school year plans.
