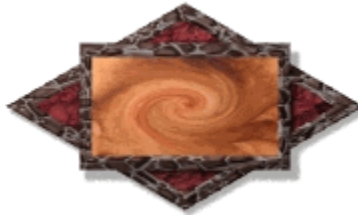

How did the angel Gabriel (alaihi wa salaam) arrive at the battle of Badr?

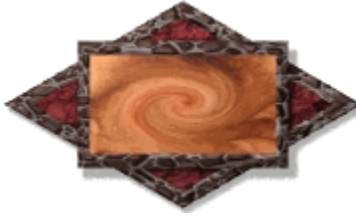
10. What advice did the prophet (salla allahu alaihi wa salaam) accept from Abu Bakr regarding the captives?
