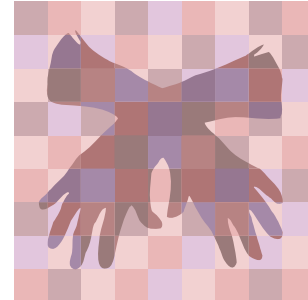

The Hijab is a controversial issue because, for instance in France they have a law banning Islamic headscarves from French state schools came into effect on Thursday September 2, 2004. Schools have been told not to automatically exclude students who arrive wearing headscarves, but to try and avoid a showdown through dialogue.

Narrated Anas (May Allah be please with him): The daughter of An-Nadr slapped a girl and broke her incisor tooth. The (the relatives of the girl) came to the messenger of Allah (salla allahu alaihi wa salaam) and he gave the order of Qisas (equality in punishment) [Sahih Al-Bukhari Vol.9 19:32]

**Or the ayaat from Allah:**

(We ordained therein for them) Life for life, eye for eye, Nose for nose, ear for ear, tooth for tooth and wounds equal for equal, but if anyone remits the Qisas by way of charity it shall be expiation for him. And whoever fails to judge by that which Allah has revealed, such are wrongdoers. [5:45]
