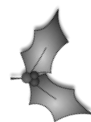




**Volunteers Needed!**

## “The Secret Place”

The word Advent means "coming" or "arrival." The focus of the entire season is preparation to celebrate the birth of Jesus the Christ. It is celebrating a truth about God, the revelation of God in Christ whereby all of creation might be reconciled to God. Advent also symbolizes the spiritual journey of individuals and a congregation, as we affirm that Christ has come, that He is present in the world today, and that He will come again in power. That acknowledgment provides a basis for Kingdom living, arising from a profound sense that we live "between the times" and are called to be faithful stewards of what is entrusted to us as God's people.

So, as we celebrate Christmas as God's entrance into "our" world where "all creation is groaning awaiting its redemption," we confess our responsibility as those called into relationship with Christ to "love the Lord your God with all your heart" and to "love your neighbor as yourself."

The Christmas story is a story of love, hope, redemption and relationship. So, what happened? How did it turn into stuff, stress and debt?

Can Christmas still change the world?

It is a question each of us must answer, as individuals and as a congregation. As you celebrate the birth of Jesus Christ this season remember there are many who do not know of the love, hope and redemption that comes through relationship with Jesus.

That mission is *"Helping others know Jesus Christ through our words and actions"*

- Following God's Word isn't an obligation, rather it is a privilege.
- Whatever our age, God has work for us to do.
- God gives us talents to match our opportunities. Today is an excellent time to analyze yours.
- Thank you God for the privilege of faithfully serving you until you call us home."

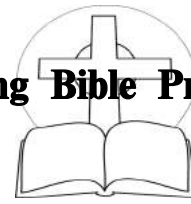

## Applying Bible Principles



December

Under the Old Testament economy, people were required to give to God because this was also the means of providing the government. A theocracy was in place then, which meant that government was actually operating under the direct authority and leadership of God Himself.

Today, we are under a different economy. However, we are still required to support the government. We may not like the way government operates. We may not agree with the policies of our governmental leaders. We may not even like the political process or the individuals involved in it.

But God says that is not the issue. The issue is one of obedience. He says we are to pay our taxes to whom we “owe taxes” (Romans 13:7). In spite of all the ills of government, God says that governmental agencies and government leaders are His “ministers” and that they operate for our ultimate “good.”

So the question is not whether we agree with or even support the work and activities of our governments at the local, state and national levels. The question is one of whether or not we will obey God. You see, it’s relatively easy to sing, “Oh, How I Love Jesus.” It’s far more difficult to demonstrate our love for Him by yielding to Him in full and complete obedience, especially when His commands are ones we do not care for – like paying our taxes.

If He is in charge, if He is Lord of our lives, then we will do what He tells us to do. As the little chorus states it so clearly, “I’ll say, ‘Yes,’ Lord, ‘Yes,’ to Your will and to Your way; ‘Yes,’ Lord, ‘Yes,’ I will trust You and obey.” Even when it comes to paying my taxes? Even when it comes to paying my taxes!

“Give to Caesar what is Caesar’s, and to God what is God’s” (Matt. 22:21).

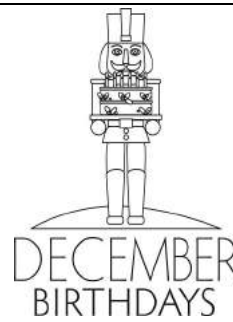

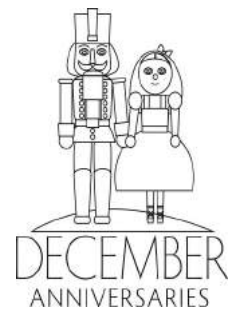

## **Migraine Headache**

Wellness Tip of the Month

### **What is it?**

Migraines are headaches that are painful and many times occur with nausea, vomiting and sensitivity to light.

### **Symptoms**

Throbbing headache pain usually aggravated by physical activity- may be on one side of the head and travel to the other side or affect the front of the head or the whole head.

Sensitivity to light, noise and odors

Nausea and vomiting, stomach upset/pain

Sensations of being very warm or cold

Fatigue

Dizziness

Blurred vision

### **Statistics**

28 million Americans have migraines

More common in women-25% of all women with migraines suffer 4 or more migraines/month.

Migraines can last from 4 hours – 3 days.

4 out of 5 sufferers have a family history of migraines

### **Migraine Triggers**

Emotional Stress

Sensitivity to specific chemicals and preservatives in foods including caffeine

Weather changes

Menstrual Periods

Excessive fatigue

Skipping meals

### **Treatment**

See your doctor if symptoms become severe or chronic. Your doctor may prescribe pain medications and/or medications for nausea. They may also be able to prescribe medications to prevent or lessen the occurrence of migraines.

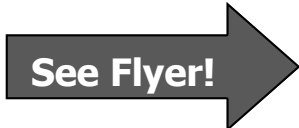
