This coming week's scripture lesson: Luke 13:31-35.

This coming week's sermon: "THE BROKEN HEART OF JESUS"

Monday, March 11: (Read Luke 13:1-9) How do you think Jesus' parable fits in with what he said about the Galileans who had died?

Tuesday, March 12: (Read Luke 13:10-17) In today's scripture lesson, Jesus clashes with a Jewish religious leader. Why do some people stress law instead of compassion?

Wednesday, March 13: (Read Luke 13:18-20) What point is Jesus making here? Compared to the organized Jewish religion of that day, the followers of Jesus were very small in number.

Thursday, March 14: (Read Luke 13:22-27) Why is the door called "narrow?" How can you be sure that you will be let in?

Friday, March 15: (Read Luke 13:28-30) Here Jesus is talking to Jews. How does knowing that lend even more weight to what He is saying?

Saturday, March 16: Read Luke 13:31-35 in preparation for tomorrow's sermon.
