Spring saw some really good catches on the lake. Check out our facebook page for photos and catch weights. However, with at least two separate spawnings followed by high temperatures and no rain during the summer months the carp were not too interested in feeding, but, as was said by anglers on more than one occasion, *'at least you can't dispute the carp are in there as we can see them all basking on the surface.'*

The new lake layout is working very well and it appears that the carp seem to be back on the feed. Things are picking up again now as a result of more settled weather with swims 3, 4 and five producing the best results. Winter feeding time is approaching!

We were very pleased to welcome Wayne of the National Anquilla Club to the lake for a bit of overnight fishing for specimen eels. In one night he banked four eels, the largest being 4lb 9ozs. Wayne enjoyed his sessions but was hoping for the 8lb+ whopper previously banked from swim 6. Another time Wayne!
