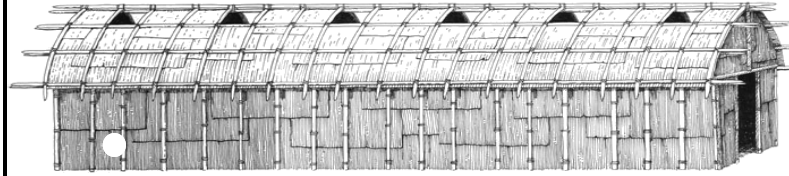


Who are the Haudenosaunee?
