Boat Ramp One Closing

The boat launch in Park One will be replaced this spring due to the rock wash-out at the end of the ramp. In order for American Shoreline to do the work, the water needs to be at a lower level and the weather must cooperate. When these conditions are met and while American Shoreline is working, the ramp will be closed to all boats. You will need to use Park Two in order to launch your boat. Remember, parking is limited at Park Two, so plan accordingly. As usual, the boat ramps at Parks 1 and 2 are to be used at your own risk, as posted.

Handouts and Volunteers



- Recently, we have had various types of handouts attached to our doors. Sometimes this is welcome, sometimes not. The problem arises when you are away from home and these items are left hanging on your door – a sure sign that the house is empty and thereby inviting a break-in. Therefore, if you plan to be away from home, you may want to inform a trusted neighbor so the telltale items can be removed. Likewise, if your neighbors are not full-time residents, you may want to check with them to determine if you should remove such items.
- Volunteers are always needed and welcome to our Association. We will need people to fill Board positions, help with the Parks, head committees, and assist with the newsletter and website. Talk to a Board member if you are interested in helping.

Dock Sale Procedure

If you are planning to sell a dock attached to Park 1, Park 2, or Park 4, you need to first contact the EPBA office to obtain a copy of the dock waiting list. People who are on the list have the first opportunity to purchase your dock and need to be contacted first. Docks must be sold to members of the Association, who by definition are property owners in Eagle Point Bay. Dock owners are responsible for maintaining their own docks.



Label your Property

Remember to label your property with your subdivision number and lot number. (Eagle Point Bay is Subdivision 14.) SIPC recommends labelling anything that can blow or float away, such as boats, docks, floats, chairs, life jackets, etc.

Boating Season is Here!

Please follow these rules so we can all enjoy the Lake:

1. Association Parks are for Association members and their accompanied guests only! Do not loan out your park key!
2. Secure the park gates after **entering** and **exiting** the parks.
3. Report all park safety issues to the EPBA.
4. Report all suspicious activity and damage to property to the Johnson County Sheriff's Department at **618-658-8264**.
5. Maintain your park dock in a safe condition. Keep your contact information current with the EPBA office.
6. Follow all Lake of Egypt and applicable Coast Guard Boating Rules. These include:
 - a. No casting within 10 feet of all docks.
 - b. Tubing and skiing are to be done in a counter-clockwise direction.
 - c. Fly an orange flag while towing a skier or tuber.
