Enjoy our Parks

- Please help keep our parks clean. Remove your garbage or place it in the receptacles provided.
- Please do not fill cans with your personal (home) garbage.
- Overnight parking/storage of vehicles and trailers IS NOT ALLOWED in the parks. The lots are for members actively using the park, ramp, or dock only.
- Please don't park on the grass.
- No fishing adjacent to the beach or 10 feet from the docks.
- The parks are for current members and their accompanied guests only. Please lock the gates upon entering and exiting.
- Children should be supervised at all times around water.
- Alcohol and weapons are not allowed in the parks.



Our parks and docks are valuable assets to our organization and its members. Please follow all the posted rules. They are in place to keep everyone safe. Enjoy your summer!

Reminder: Label Your Property!

A severe storm passed through our area on June 28, 2018. Damages varied, from uprooted trees to overturned floating docks. Let this be a reminder to everyone to clearly label your property with your subdivision number and lot number. Eagle Point Bay is Subdivision number 14. If you own lot 271, then your property should be labeled 14-271. SIPC recommends labeling anything that can blow or float away, such as boats, docks, floats, chairs, life jackets, etc. This will help protect your property in the event of another such storm!

Making Waves

Leaving a wake in No Wake zones is not only against the Lake of Egypt rules, it is rude and costly to homeowners in those areas. However, waves also damage docks on all parts of the lake. If you are enjoying your boat or jet ski on the lake, please remember to keep a reasonable distance from docks and shorelines so your neighbors don't incur added expenses for upkeep to their properties. Also remember that there is a 35 mph speed limit on Lake of Egypt. Thanks!

Park Dock Information

Dock owners are required to maintain their dock section in a safe condition. Repairs should be made immediately when issues are identified. Our docks are part of a shared system, and it's important to keep them safe for all users and to ensure the integrity of the entire dock system.

The 2018 Annual Membership/Dock Fees were due March 1st. If you have not paid yet, please do so asap.

Dock owners are required to have a current liability policy and provide a copy of the policy information with your annual renewal.

OFFICIAL LAKE OF EGYPT RULES AND REGULATIONS - SOUTHERN ILLINOIS POWER COOPERATIVE

Among the rules SIPC has posted for Lake of Egypt are the following:

Water skiing is limited to the northern wide area of lake. Skiers shall not ski closer than 100 feet from shoreline or buoyline. Skiers will ski in counterclockwise direction. This applies to Jet Skis also. No skiing after sundown.

Boating: No one under the influence of alcohol may operate a boat on the Lake of Egypt. Racing is prohibited. The speed limit is 35 miles per hour.

JET SKIS – follow State Law – same as for boats. Jet skis are not allowed on the lake after sundown.

Fishing: ABSOLUTELY NO CASTING OF LURES WITHIN 10 FEET OF DOCKS, BOATS, OR BOAT HOUSES.

Swimming is prohibited except at approved beaches marked by buoys. Air mattresses are prohibited outside of beach areas.
