Dear Brethren,

We were blessed by two precious souls, baptized into Christ for the remission of their sins. The first one was Jordy Fils-ainé with whom I had regular weekly Bible studies. He was baptized on



September 4th by his father. At first he wanted me to baptize him since I had been studying with him, but I told his father it would be better for him to baptize his own son. it would make a closer relation between him and his own son.

The second one happened on September 29th, I immersed Veronique Inchauspe, an Ivory-Coast lady, married to a French lawyer, with 4 children aged from 11 to 20 years old.

After having studying with her she decided to put on Christ on baptism. In fact the very Sunday after her baptism she came to worship with her oldest son. We are planning on continuing to study.

Since the last part of September, I have been studying with a new contact. Her name is Cecilia; she is studying to be a stenographer (jurist in French) here in Paris. When Rose asked her about having a Bible study she replied yes without any hesitation so I talked to her and we made an appointment to study every Saturday!

She comes to the building for her study, but she continues to come to worship also, most of the time on Sunday nights. What is wonderful about her, is the fact that she really wants to learn. Besides our Bible study together she is also following a Bible correspondence course with me. I trust the Lord that she most likely will obey the gospel soon. So far this year we had blessed with eight baptisms.

This past month we had the visit of Ken and Ida Wilson. I have known Ken since the 1980 and I know that he and his wife worked in the vineyard of the Lord , in France, Belgium , Benin, Africa , Germany ,Vietnam and in several states. While they stayed with us I took them to visit Brother Hubert and Raymonde Noblet in la Rochelle. The Noblet family have been faithful members of the Lord's church, since the 1960's they moved there to be closer to their children , but unfortunately there not a congregation near them. Even our visit was too short, but it was a wonderful uplifting

visit for us and for them. From La Rochelle I drove to Caen were brother Steven Mendez lives. We visited the WWII Museum and afterward ate together and then we headed back to Paris. While with us Brother Ken preached in French at both services French and English, and it was a blessing to have them with us.
