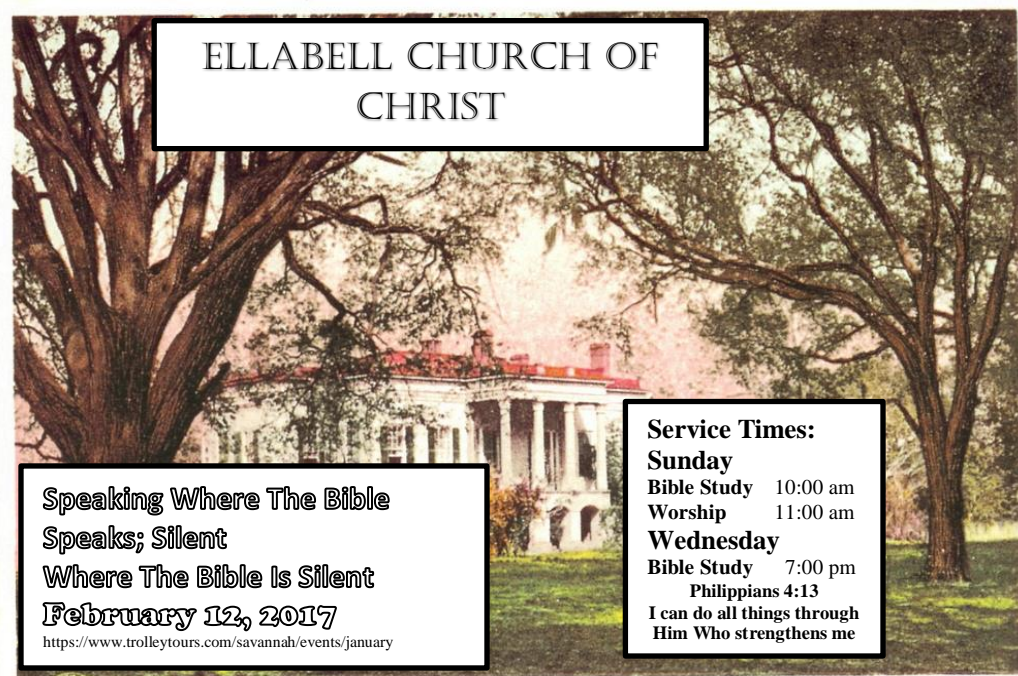

REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF JANUARY 2017 (TOM EK POT –JR)

Dearly beloved in Christ, I salute you all in Jesus name. My wife and children send greeting to you all. Thank you for your continuous prayers for us in Nigeria and Cameroun. May God continue to bless each and every one of you richly in all your good works. For those of us who listen to News concerning Africa, you might have heard of the violence that continues to claim lives of people in Northern Nigeria. Since the fourth quarter of last year till now, the next state to Plateau where we live began to witness the terror of the Islamic militants. Several Christians have been killed. Many people have become refugees in where they called their home. Children have been rendered orphans, and several women become untimely widows. We are constantly praying for God's intervention, because left for man alone, the problem will not end since the Muslims want to clear every Christian from the Northern Nigeria. To say that we constantly live in fear even in Plateau as the onslaught continues in Kaduna State is not an

understatement. We know if God does not intervene, Plateau is next target. However, we know that this is not above the intervention of our almighty God. That is why we are calling upon Him daily to hear our pleas.

The month of January like every other first month of the year was a challenging one in different ways. During December, some people spent too much for Christmas celebration and run out of cash. One cannot help but to assist in several situations. In Nigeria, the case was even more complex as Nigeria economy fell below expectation. Prices of common food stuffs doubled what it ever was even in the last quarter of last year. With the current killings, farmers could not enter bush to harvest their produce. Draught affected crop production in other areas. We need your daily prayers my brethren.

I mentioned to you some time past of the establishment of children class at Foron congregation. I am glad the class is progressing. You can see below a cross section of some of the children during their last month presentation.



I have gotten series of materials and am editing them for our needs. When I am done with these children lesson materials, there will be useful in training up children from age 5

to sixteen. I want to make the lessons available for other congregations as well. The aim of these lessons is to help children grow up in the knowledge of God, to making decision to be baptized for their salvation when they attain the age of decision making.

After a long time, I had to return to see the church at Toro as they made several calls for me to come. The church

is moving, through evangelism effort of the church, several young people have become members of the church.



I was sad on the other side because some of the old members have stopped coming for worship for diverse reasons. I was unable to meet them very because

of the dangers posed by the Islamic militants along the road. Now I see the need for me to regular myself on that road again despite the threat. I know it is God that protects, I believe He will not allow evil to befall me except it is a must that I have to drink the cup.

My wife (Sandra) started women class at Mazah, and that class is progressing alongside our general Bible class every Friday. She saw the need to start another class with some teenage girls. She was worried that those girls have not been baptized. To God's glory, one of them was baptized last month. That gives Sandra the encouragement to continue to class. The materials I am working on is of great help to her. At the School of Biblical Studies, all my students resumed for the second semester except one who deferred his studies.

On a sad note, I lost my friend's wife, who came down with diabetic illness. Her husband (a preacher and my former student) and her were my good friends and coworker. I really miss her, but give glory to God that she was a Christian. Once again, let me appreciate you all again for taking time to pray for us and supporting us. May God continue to bless you all.
