**Beginning the first Sunday of July, Good Shepherd will return to a single weekend service.** Our final Saturday service will be offered on June 26.

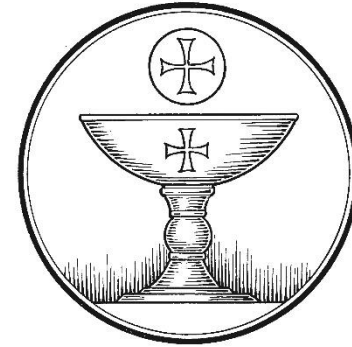
Coffee and treats will resume on July 4<sup>th</sup>. If you are interested in signing up to serve, please do so in the fellowship hall.
