To our visitors and guests:

The Lord's Supper is celebrated at Good Shepherd in the confession and glad confidence that our Lord, as He says, gives not only bread and wine, but His very body and blood to eat and drink for the forgiveness of sin. In joyful obedience to the clear teaching of our Lord Jesus those are invited to His table who trust His words, repent of all sin, and set aside any refusal to forgive and love as He forgives and loves us. They show forth His death until He comes. Because Holy Communion is a confession of the faith which is confessed at this altar, any who are not yet instructed, in doubt, or who hold a confession differing from that of The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod and so are unable to receive the Sacrament are invited to meditate on God's Word in the distribution hymns and pray for the day when divisions will have ceased. You may also come up to the rail and receive a baptismal blessing. Signify this by crossing your hands over your chest. If you have any questions, please feel free to talk to Pastor.

Pastor, what religious exercises were prescribed for the several hours?

Matins, before day-break, Meditation on the Divine Word, for the reading of which, full and regular provision is made in this hour. Lauds, at dawn Praise. As the birds and all nature begin their song, the praise of the Creator and Redeemer breaks forth.

Prime, Supplication, for at this hour man looks forward to the day's work, and again takes up the battle of life.

Tierce, Sext and Nones, at 9, 12, and 3 o'clock, Hallowing the day. These hours have the same structure, and with Prime, have divided among them the 119 Psalm; for in the toil and sweat of the day, the soul must again and again be directed to the Divine Word, with which every verse of this Psalm is occupied.

Vespers, at the close of the day, Prayer, praise and thanksgiving. As the believer looks back over the course of the day, he seeks relief from its distractions, toils and care, and then rejoices in all his blessings, and the riches of the grace of God.

Compline, at night, peculiarly the evening hour of Prayer, in which the Christian looks forward into the night with its terrors and works of darkness, and commits himself and his into the safe hands of his Lord.

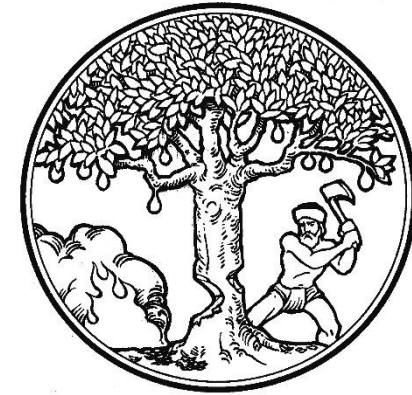
