GSPHC BENEFIT HORSE/RIDER CLASSES: We raised \$560 from these at the 2013 GSPHC show. It was voted to send \$600 to the winner's charity of choice - Arthritis Research.

ZONE 7 SHOW COMMITTEE REPORT: Ashley Nolasco reported the following from the Zone 7 Annual Meeting, November 23, 24, 2013.

- The 2012 Zone Show showed a \$12,000 loss.
- There will again be 10 judges on Saturday.
- There will be a Bridleless Calcutta on Saturday.
- There will also be class circuit high points in every class for the highest pointed Zone resident.
- There will again be many "give-aways".
- Money raffle tickets will be sold by Zone 7 Club members with the winner to be drawn at the April GSPHC Paint Show.
- Stall reservations will be taken by Dorothy Quirk.
- Stalls and camper hook-ups will not have to be prepaid.
- Heather Mounts will handle the office.
- All Youth classes will be "18 and under".
