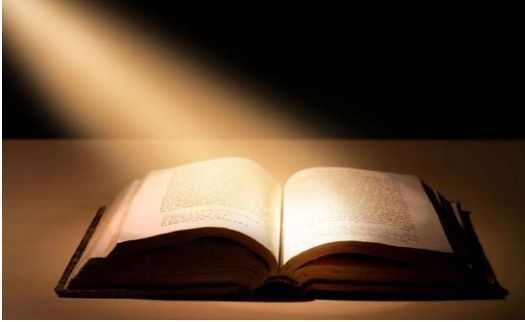

Sharing the Truth with Family

Perhaps the most difficult people to witness to are family members. It may be because we love them so much and want them so badly to know the truth as we know it. When you come to Christ as your Savior, it changes your life forever. It is a sweet experience, besides a life changing experience, that we want to share with those we love even though it is difficult.

The Apostle Peter shares how this difficult work of love can be accomplished with family members we love so much. Basically, it is living a life of godliness before them. No nagging or verbal battles. We should take to heart what he says:

Likewise, ye wives, be in subjection to your own husbands; that, if any obey not the word, they also may without the word be won by the conversation of the wives; While they behold your chaste conversation coupled with fear. Whose adorning let it not be that outward adorning of plaiting the hair, and of wearing of gold, or of putting on of apparel; But let it be the hidden man of the heart, in that which is not corruptible, even the ornament of a meek and quiet spirit, which is in the sight of God of great price. For after this manner in the old time the holy women also, who trusted in God, adorned themselves, being in subjection unto their own husbands: Even as Sara obeyed Abraham, calling him lord: whose daughters ye are, as long as ye do well, and are not afraid with any amazement. Likewise, ye husbands, dwell with them according to knowledge, giving honour unto the wife, as unto the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life; that your prayers be not hindered (1 Peter 3:1-7).

1. Know your place (subjection) (vs. 1)
2. Keep your tongue (without the word) (vs. 1)
3. Have a godly behavior (conversation) (vs. 1)
4. Have a genuinely pure behavior (conversation) (vs. 2)
5. Have a genuine fear of God (vs. 2)
6. Work on the beauty of the inner person (vs. 3-4)
7. Have a meek and quiet spirit before man and God (vs. 4-5)
8. Show respect without fear one to another (vs. 6-7)

These exhortations by Peter may also be considered a promise you can claim when you are dealing with loved ones who are some of the most difficult to win for Christ. These exhortations can be claimed by a wife, a husband, a child, a brother or sister, a father, a mother, an uncle or aunt, cousins, and even friends who are difficult to win to Christ.

Identifying the Child of God

Are you a child of God? This ia a question everyone should answer before he dies. To identify if you are child of God, look at their characteristics:

- I. The child of God is identified as one who does the righteousness of God (vs. 10)
- II. The child of God is identified as one who loves the brethren (vs. 10)
- III. The child of God is identified as one who believes in Jesus Christ the Son of God as Savior (vs. 23)

Do you have the righteousness of Jesus Christ as your eternal protection (2 Corinthians 5:24)? Do you love the brethren? Have you received the Lord Jesus, the Son of God, as your Savior? Are you saved? It is really important for where you will spend your eternity.

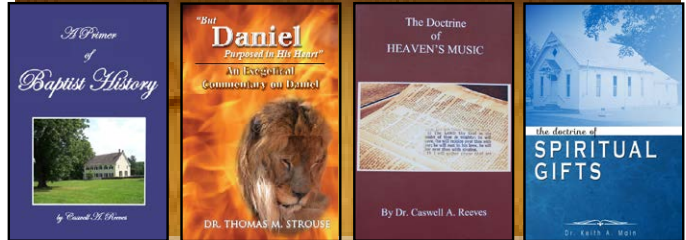

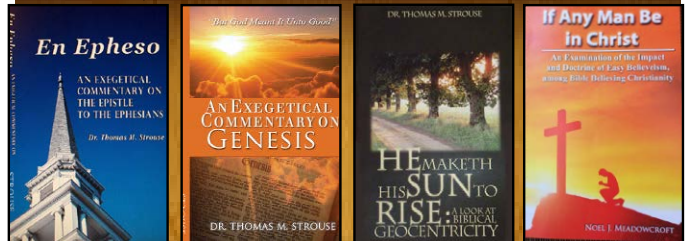

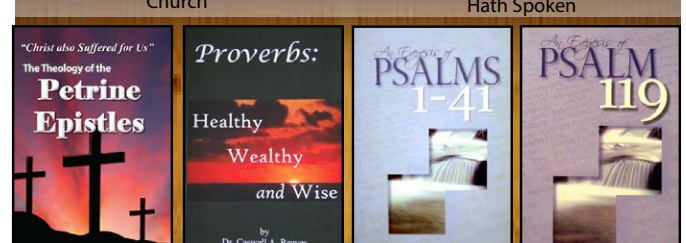
