LIBERTY IN THE BIBLE

Liberty means walking free - Acts 26:32:

Then said Agrippa unto Festus, This man might have been set at liberty, if he had not appealed unto Caesar.

Liberty follows God's rules and enjoys free will - 1 Corinthians 7:39:

The wife is bound by the law as long as her husband liveth; but if her husband be dead, she is at liberty to be married to whom she will; only in the Lord.

Liberty brings responsible behavior with it - 1 Corinthians 8:9:

But take heed lest by any means this liberty of yours become a stumblingblock to them that are weak.

Liberty is freedom - Galatians 5:1:

Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.

Liberty is to be used rightly - Galatians 5:13:

For, brethren, ye have been called unto liberty; only use not liberty for an occasion to the flesh, but by love serve one another.

Liberty that is perfect is found in the Bible - James 1:25:

But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed.

Liberty should not desire to bring injury - 1 Peter 2:16:

As free, and not using your liberty for a cloke of maliciousness, but as the servants of God.

Liberty that is truly free is from Jesus Christ - John 8:36:

If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.

Did you know that there are some people that God has a problem with and some people who God will allow to be destroyed? Nevertheless, God is our hope, and He wants to help the sinner.



- I. People that God has a problem with (4:1)
 - A. Those without truth - no honesty
 - B. Those without mercy - no kindness/goodness
 - C. Those without knowledge of God - no standard
 - D. Those who are disingenuous (7:14-16)
 1. They know they should repent (6:1-6)
 - a. they have been torn (vs. 1)
 - b. they know God's help (vs. 1-2)
 - c. they know God's blessing (vs. 3)
 2. They know God desires mercy (vs. 6)
 3. They know God desires knowledge of God (vs. 6)
 4. They deal treacherously (vs. 7)
 - E. Those who no longer trust in the Lord (8:13-14)
- polluted, 9:4; corrupt, 9:9; divided heart, 10:2; liars, 10:4
- II. People that God allows to be destroyed (4:6ff)
 - A. Those that reject knowledge (vs. 6)
 - B. Those that are proud (vs. 7)
 - C. Those with an appetite for sin (vs. 8)

 2. They can expect no satisfaction (vs. 10)
 3. They can expect a misguided heart (vs. 11)
 4. They can expect the loss of God's presence (5:15)
- III. God's invitation (10:12)

 - C. His declaration (13:4)
 - D. His promise (13:9)
 - E. His pronouncement (14:9)
