Trip to the Philippines

On the 13th of September, I flew out of Binghamton, New York, to Detroit, Michigan, and then to Tokyo, Japan, and from Japan to Manila, Philippines - a total of 26 hours of travel. The Philippines are exactly 12 hours ahead of our time here in New York, so our arrival was at eight o'clock Friday evening. Upon my arrival, *Dr. Raquintan* and *Bro. Robin Santiago*, a seminary student, met me at the

airport. We then traveled to Quezon City where the **Cornerstone Baptist Church** is located.

Prior to my arrival, the island was alerted to a typhoon. This alert caused many to stay in their homes and off the roads, which made for easy travel on a Friday night. So the trip to the church was a relatively short one compared to other times.

Saturday was a day of rest, and Sunday was a full day of preaching in the **Cornerstone Baptist Church** in Quezon City and in **Pampanga**, which is a church plant of Cornerstone about two hours north of Quezon City and pastored by *Alvin Bautista*, a student in the seminary directed by *Dr. Jed Raquintan*. On the way we saw evidence of the typhoon in the flooded rice farms.

On Monday we began the seminary module week with *Dr. Raquintan* teaching **Contemporary Theology** in the morning, while I taught the books of **Colossians** and **Philemon** in the evening. On Friday we concluded our modules on our respective studies. Following some refreshments, the students departed for the bus station, the airport, and other sources of transportation, heading home. The week of classes went very well with both classes having ten to twelve students participating. Of these students, half were pastors from a number of Baptist churches throughout the Philippines.

Again, Sunday was a full day of preaching in the morning service, a devotional to the men in the afternoon, and preaching again in the evening service. Following some farewells and fellowship, it was time to pack what the very generous members at **Cornerstone** had given me to take home to the church folks at **Heritage Baptist Church**. After some sleep, *Dr. Raquintan* took me to the airport in Manila for the flight back home. I left Manila at 8:00 AM for Tokyo and then to the USA. I am grateful that the Lord gave me a wonderful time in sharing the **words of God which are truth**.

The Preservation of the Scripture

Message by *Dr. Caswell A. Reeves*

Today among theologians there is and has been a debate on whether the Words of God are supernaturally preserved unto this present day. Regardless of whether the rationalism of man can understand or accept the preservation of the Scripture or not, still the God who cannot lie has declared His preservation of His words, the Scripture:



1. Psalm 12:6-7 - "...LORD, thou shalt preserve them..."
2. Psalm 105:8 - "...the word which He commanded to a thousand generations."
3. Psalm 119:89 - "...Thy word is settled in heaven."
4. Psalm 119:152 - "...Thou hast founded them for ever."
5. Psalm 119:160 - "Thy word is true...endureth forever."
6. Isaiah 40:8 - "...but the word of our God shall stand for ever."
7. Matthew 24:35 - "...My words shall not pass away."
8. Luke 24:27 - Christ quoted Moses and all the prophets as being preserved words of the Old Testament.
9. John 10:35 - "...scripture cannot be broken."

The preservation of Scripture is not up to man to fulfill. It is God's responsibility to preserve it. Man's responsibility is to receive the Scripture by faith and to obey it. The Psalmist declared: "Thou shalt keep them (God's words in scripture), O LORD, thou shalt preserve them from this generation for ever."
