Biblical Genealogies



The study of the Bible's genealogies is very interesting. For example, Adam lived to be 930 years old. Further, the Bible records that Lamech, Noah's father, was 56 years old when Adam died. Noah was born when Lamech was 182 years old. Noah was 500 years old before he had the Bible's first recorded set of triplets: Japheth, Ham, and Shem, in that order from the oldest to the youngest. The Flood was 1656 years after the creation. And Methuselah, the oldest man to live at 969 years, died in the year of the flood. The genealogies also reveal that Noah had been working on the Ark for 20 years before his sons were born. Another point of interest, Noah lived 950 years; this means that when Noah died, Abraham was 58 years of age. Abraham's father, Terah, lived 250 years and died the same year that Isaac married Rebekah. A side note, not from the Bible, but from Jewish tradition regarding Melchizedek, king of Salem of whom Abraham was blessed and to whom he paid a tithe of all the spoils from the slaughter of Chedorlaomer, the tradition holds that Shem, the son of Noah, was Melchizedek. Interestingly, the Bible's genealogies record that Shem was still alive at this time. Finally, although there are many interesting things to learn from the genealogies, the primary purpose is to prove that Jesus Christ has a human lineage, which goes back to Adam. It reveals and proves the Jesus Christ is the "seed" promised to Adam and Eve. Jesus is the promised "Redeemer" for Adam's fallen race - the biblical evidence is undeniable as proven from the Bible's genealogy lists.

- VII. It is a separated church (vs.9)
 - a church with holy principles and practices
- VIII. It is a pre-tribulation church (vs.10)
 - a church with “a blessed hope”
