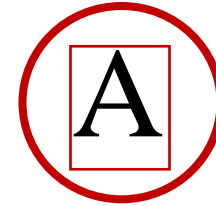

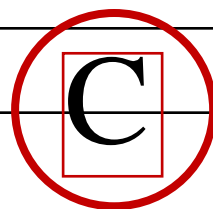

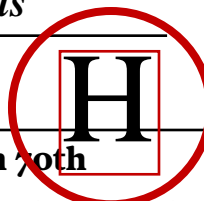

She loves to bake and share her work with family and friends. She wants to be a chef when she grows up and own her own restaurant. Her specialty will be cookies.

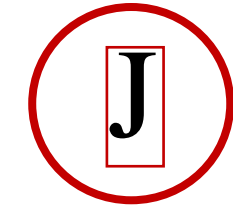


**Suzanne Renee Mowrey**
