## KDCTA RULES AND REGULATIONS

- NO REFUNDS AFTER CLOSING DATE -

*Consideration of refund with vet certificate only*

1. Registration Booth opens at 8:00AM. All Rings start at 9:00 AM unless otherwise stated.
2. COGGINS: A copy of a negative Coggins taken within 12 months of the show date is required for each horse entered. If no proof of Coggins, you will be asked to leave the show grounds.
3. **Dressage Classes must be pre-registered.** Post dated entries, if available, will be filled on a first come, first serve basis. Entries for **Hunter/ Jumper ring will be accepted until the previous class begins. If riding both dressage & hunter/ jumper classes, must pre-register all classes.**
4. The decisions of the judges and show secretary/manager are final. USEF rules will be followed.
5. The show management reserves the right to cancel, combine, add or divide classes if conditions warrant.
6. AGE: As of January 1st Jr Riders = 18 years & under, Sr. Riders = 19 years and up.
7. DRESS: Dress will be casual, but suitable boots and an ASTM certified helmet are required for every rider while mounted anywhere on show grounds. Hunter and/or Dressage or Western attire is encouraged but not required. Paddock boots and half chaps are allowed. Full chaps are not acceptable in English classes.
8. COPIES OF DRESSAGE TESTS are available upon request from the show secretary for \$1 per test or may be printed from the USDF and USEF/USEA, WDDA websites.
9. ALL DOGS must be leashed at all times.
10. DRESSAGE: Readers are permitted for all tests. USDF 2015 Intro tests and USEF 2015 Training Level and above, 2017 WDDA tests will be used. No Horse/Rider combination may enter more than two consecutive dressage levels. Suitability and Equitation classes to be judged as a group. Higher level tests may be ridden upon request. All Dressage Classes must be pre-registered/pre-paid.
11. MUSICAL FREESTYLE & QUADRILLE: May ride test of choice or create your own. Any number of riders allowed. Music must be at the announcer's stand 1 hour prior to class. CD format.
12. STALLIONS: Must be well mannered and pre-registered.
13. All returned checks will be charged an additional \$30 fee.

## **KDCTA RULES AND REGULATIONS**

### **Specific Rules for May 12 Dressage Only Show**

1. STABLING: Stalls must be requested on pre-registration entry form. Limited stalls available, check with manager for availability. \$30 full day, \$15 1/2 day (8am-12pm OR 12pm-4pm.)
2. PARKING: Trailer parking only in designated areas. No trailers next to barn except for loading/unloading.
3. GROUNDS FEE: \$20 per horse/rider combo on the grounds. Jr. Riders \$15
4. CLASS FEES: All Jr Riders get a \$5 discount on class fees.  
**Dressage:** \$25 per test (late fee \$20 /horse-rider)  
Scratches after closing date will incur a \$20 office fee  
**Freestyle:** \$25 per test  
**Pas de Deux/Quadrille:** \$5 per rider/ \$25 minimum (please have one person pay for all riders and list names on entry form)
5. AWARDS: All dressage tests will be placed using the Danish System. 1st-6th place.  
**Foxfire Memorial Trophy:** Anyone of any age can sign up. Must be taking at least 2 lessons a month. Awarded to highest average of 2 or more dressage tests. Free-Sign up on line and on entry form.

### **Specific Rules for June 23 Open Show**

1. STABLING: No Stalls. Must work out of trailer.
2. GROUNDS FEE: \$5 per horse/rider combo on the grounds.
4. CLASS FEES: \$5 per class.
5. ENTRIES: Please make entries at least two (2) classes prior to the class you wish to enter. Please use the Scratch / Add form
6. GATE CALL: The show will run with a 2 minute gate. This means the gate will close 2 minutes after the first horse enters the ring. This WILL BE enforced.
7. AWARDS: 1st-6th place in all classes.
8. Judges decision final.

# KDCTA RULES AND REGULATIONS

## Specific Rules for September 22 Dressage/Hunter/ Jumper Show

1. HEALTH PAPERS: Grange Fair Equine Park requires that all horses have a 30-day vet certificate and a current coggins available **upon request**. Negative Coggins must be presented.
2. STABLING: \$30 per horse stall / \$30 per tack stall. **Stalls do not need to be stripped before leaving**. Stall floors are macadam. Wheel barrows available. Shavings available for \$8 per bale. Stalls and shavings must be requested on pre-registration entry form.
3. PARKING: Trailer Parking only in designated area No trailers next to the barn except for unloading.
4. GROUNDS FEE: \$20 per horse/rider combo on the grounds. Jr. Riders \$15
4. CLASS FEES: All Jr. Riders get a \$5 discount on class fees. **Lead Line: \$10**  
**Dressage:** \$25 per test (late fee \$20 /horse-rider) Scratches after closing date will incur a \$20 office fee  
**Freestyle:** \$25 per test  
**Pas de Deux/Quadrille:** \$5 per rider/ \$25 minimum (please have one person pay for all riders and list names on entry form)  
**Suitability /Equitation Classes:** \$15 per Class  
**Hunter/ Jumpers:** \$15 per Class, \$10 per Schooling Round
5. HUNTER/JUMPER DIVISIONS: These divisions will follow the rules and regulations of the Central PA Hunter Circuit. Refer to [www.kdcta.org](http://www.kdcta.org) or [www.thecphc.com](http://www.thecphc.com)
6. STAKE CLASSES: You must enter at least one other class in the division to qualify for the stakes class.
7. SCHOOLING over fences is only permitted in warm-up ring or during open schooling. There will be NO lunging of horses in any rings after 8:00AM.
8. REFUNDS & CLASS CANCELLATIONS: In the case where a horse has been entered and not shown in a Dressage class fees will be forfeited. Refunds will only be made with a vet certificate minus a \$20 office fee.
9. AWARDS: All dressage tests will be placed using the Danish system. 1st thru 6th places in all types of classes. Hunter Divisions will receive Champion. and Res. Champion ribbons. Stakes Payback: \$12, \$7, \$5, \$4, \$2, \$1
