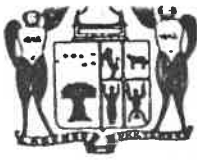
Candidates were Obligated by our Grand First Principal Clifford E. Storie and Bibles presented by John C. James.


