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## Thanksgiving Potluck Luncheon

We will be having our annual student Potluck Luncheon this week on Thursday and Friday from 11:15am-12:15pm. Our Thanksgiving luncheon is one of the kids' favorite events. They love the festive holiday dinner...hot food...and it is positive, fun, and a time for the kids to celebrate Thanksgiving with their friends. All students are invited to the luncheon, even if they only take one or two classes and don't normally join us for lunch.

Students are welcome to host a table. They will be responsible to decorate it. We will have a contest and prizes for the host (can be more than one host per table) for the best design/decorations. Just bring your decorations with you to school this week and let Pam know in the office first thing so she can assign you a table.

With our Thanksgiving theme in mind, we ask that all families use the following as a guide for bringing a covered dish:

Last name A-F: please bring a dessert

Last name G-O: please bring a main dish

Last name P-Z: please bring a side dish

Ideas of what to bring for Side Dish: potato/macaroni salads, fruit, jello, green salads, mash potatoes, beans, rice, corn; Main Dish: meat balls, spaghetti, turkey, ham, chicken, sandwiches; Desserts: pies, cakes, cookies.

Remember about a 1/3 of the students are gluten free and/or dairy free. We will have one table marked gluten free. There is a small microwave available, along with a fridge, if you need to bring in your covered dish earlier in the day.

We could use some parental helpers with this event to help set up the tables and clean up afterwards, especially with cleanup as we will be having classes in the lunchroom right after lunch. All volunteers are welcome to join us for lunch. Many hands make little work, and your support will help get our classrooms ready in time for our afternoon classes.
