Halter and Pleasure Helpers:

If you need relief to get ready for your own class, let me know & I'll juggle begin/end times:

1 person to check in the entries for the halter/pleasure part of show (7:45 - 10:00) ~Halter & WT

1 person to check in the entries for the pleasure part of show (10:00 - 12:00) ~ WP/HMS

1 person to check in the entries for the pleasure part of show (12:00 - end) (~RR/English)

(These people also run the entry gate as needed)

1 person to run the exit gate for halter/pleasure part of show (8:30 - 10:00) ~ Walk Trot

1 person to run the exit gate for pleasure part of show (10:00 - 12:00) ~ WP/HMS

1 person to run the exit gate for pleasure part of show (12:00 - end) (~RR/English)

Trail Helpers:

Set up outdoor arena for trail @ 11 AM

Help reset obstacles that move during class (estimated time of 1 - 4 p.m.)

Take down outdoor trail obstacles - probably during Jumping Figure 8

Timed Event Helpers: Officers and Reps will measure the settings pre-event.

Preferably 2 people to organize the runners outside of arena; in barn if raining Stake/Barrels

Preferably 2 people to organize the runners outside of arena; in barn if raining Flag & Jpg. Fig 8

Preferably 2 people to organize the runners outside of arena; in barn if raining Poles/Keyhole

Run in & out gates during timed events. We need 4 at all times, with at least one adult

at each gate. Each shift below is about 1/2 hour. These people reset dropped barrels, poles, etc.

8 & under and 9-13 Stake Race

14-18 and 19 & Over Stake

8 & under and 9-13 Barrels

14-18 and 19 & Over Barrels

8 & under and 9-13 Texas Flag

14-18 and 19 & Over Texas Flag

8 & under and 9-13 Jumping Fig. 8

14-18 and 19 & Over Jumping Fig. 8

8 & under and 9-13 Pole Bending

14-18 and 19 & Over Pole Bending

8 & under and 9-13 Keyhole

14-18 and 19 & Over Keyhole

Texas Flag - need 2 people to move flags between barrels.
