

## Ward Post Stake Conference Primary Advisor Checklist

Week of August 12<sup>th</sup> to August 17<sup>th</sup>

- Help relocate auxiliary closets (SCW to Newport, RHW to San Juan, OHW to Yorba) PCW, EW, PW, TMW remain in their current locations.
- Obtain a list of any new members of your class and learn their names.
- Primary advisors plan and execute a fun activity for the 14<sup>th</sup> for the new combined building youth group making sure to include all participants from both wards.
- Recommend to bishopric any new primary advisors needed to fill positions vacated by boundary realignment.
- Consider a special sharing time, singing time, and get to know you welcome time for this first Sunday following conference. It will be the first gathering of the newly formed ward primary so the teachers and students will need to meet and greet each other.

Within one month of Conference.

- Make visits as a presidency to every new child's household.
- Follow guidelines in new combined building activity groups to plan and carry out quality weekly class activities.

Other considerations -

- Pay special attention to recent move ins and reactivated members and new converts and investigators so they don't get lost with all the changes.
- Look for opportunities for class service projects. A class that serves together, stays together.
- Be sensitive and on the lookout for those in your primary organization who may be less enthusiastic about the boundary changes.
