

Ward Post Stake Conference Youth Advisor Checklist

Week of August 12th to August 17th

- Help relocate auxiliary closets (SCW to Newport, RHW to San Juan, OHW to Yorba) PCW, EW, PW, TMW remain in their current locations.
- Obtain a list of any new members of your class and learn their names.
- YM/YW advisors plan and execute a fun activity for the 14th for the new combined building youth group making sure to include all participants from both wards.
- Recommend to bishopric any new adult advisors and youth leaders needed to fill positions vacated by boundary realignment.
- Assign the discussion leader for the 3rd Sunday lesson and plan a welcome/get to know you activity during your 2nd hour since this will be the first gathering of the newly formed Sunday class.

Within one month of Conference.

- Make visits as a presidency to every new youth household.
- Follow guidelines in new combined building activity groups to plan and carry out quality weekly class activities and the monthly joint activity.

Other considerations -

- Pay special attention to recent move ins and reactivated members and new converts and investigators so they don't get lost with all the changes.
- Look for opportunities for class or quorum service projects. A class that serves together, stays together.
- Be sensitive and on the lookout for those in your ward who may be less enthusiastic about the boundary changes.
