
2018-19 DIRECT DONATION CAMPAIGN

Point Grey Secondary School is a highly regarded school, committed to supporting and teaching a diverse group of students to learn, to critically reflect, and to care for themselves and others as they prepare to find their place in the world. *Thank you to all the families who responded to our fundraising appeal at the beginning of the school year by making a donation to the Point Grey PAC.* You helped us raise \$8,000 through our first appeal, and we're hoping to raise even more with your financial support.

With ongoing provincial education funding cuts, the need for direct funding from families and our community is a crucial and growing trend. We are seeking to raise \$25,000 to cover some of our basic budgetary demands and enrichment programs that allows the teachers and staff at Point Grey Secondary to achieve their mission to help, educate and support our children for a bright future.

Every year the PG PAC asks members of the school community to submit applications for funds they would like to receive towards their program to further benefit the students. This year the requests for 2018 came to over \$42, 000. Point Grey received approximately \$21,000 from the gaming grant (*these funds can only be used for non-curricular items*), and these funds have been completely utilized. We also used general PAC funds available from fundraising initiatives to support the requests, but we still have a shortfall of approximately \$11,000 to fulfill.

HOW YOU CAN HELP

We are seeking to raise \$25,000 to cover the funding requests of the faculty and staff at Point Grey Secondary School. Ideally we would like to raise more to put some monies aside for future years' funding requests. Direct Donation is fully tax deductible*, giving you the power to fund programs identified by the Point Grey PAC (Parent Advisory Council) which is 100% volunteer run. The library at Point Grey is very popular and well used amongst the students at the secondary school. It is very important to keep it well stocked as it provides a print rich environment with improved literacy and language acquisition for all the students at the school. The library budget has been cut drastically in the past year. We would like to raise \$10,000 so that upgrades can be made and new materials can be purchased for use by all the students.

Technology is an integral part of life and the advancement of it on a yearly basis is amazing. The current age of the computers at Point Grey is about 6 years old and upgrades for these computers need to be made for increased performance. Due to budgetary cuts, the school is short \$15,000 in funds and has requested help from the parents to fund the technology upgrades. These computers are located in the Information Technology Lab, Business Education Lab and Library. They are used by all the students at the school for some class or another and require serious attention. Technology is the future, we really should support the school in this initiative.
