



2017-2018 STATE OF ILLINOIS SCHOOL HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

Note: All health records must be submitted to the Health Office **PRIOR** to the first day of school, unless otherwise noted. All exams must be complete and recorded on State of Illinois Examination forms only. Completed forms may be faxed to St. Mary School at (815)747-6188. Authorized forms are available on the St. Mary School website (www.stmary-ed.org) or Illinois State Board of Education websites (links follow at the end of this document). Failure to comply with the State of Illinois regulations will result in exclusion from school beginning October 16.

BIRTH CERTIFICATE REQUIREMENT

ILLINOIS LAW REQUIRES that all students enrolling in an IL school for the first time must submit a certified copy of their original birth certificate. Parents who are unable to provide a certified copy of their child's birth certificate must submit a signed GENERAL AFFIDAVIT explaining the reason why they are unable to provide a certified copy of the birth certificate along with a Passport, Visa, or other government issued documentation showing reliable proof of their child's identity and

ENTERING PRESCHOOL:

- Official Government issued Birth Certificate, Baptismal Certificate
- Physical Examination must be completed within one calendar year prior to the date of entry. The exam must include up-to-date immunizations and medical history.

ENTERING KINDERGARTEN:

- Physical Examination must be completed within one calendar year prior to the date of entry. The exam must include up-to-date immunizations and medical history.
- Eye Examination must be performed by a licensed optometrist within one year prior to the first day of school and submitted before October 15 of the school year.
- Dental Examination must be performed by a licensed dentist and submitted prior to May 15 of the school year. Dental exams must be completed within 18 months prior to the May 15 deadline.

ENTERING 1st GRADE:

- Must have previous Kindergarten physical on file and be compliant with all immunization requirements.

ENTERING 2nd GRADE:

- Dental Examination must be performed by a licensed dentist and submitted prior to May 15 of the school year. Dental exams must be completed within 18 months prior to the May 15 deadline.

ENTERING 3rd GRADE :

- Must have previous Kindergarten physical on file and be compliant with all immunization requirements.

ENTERING 4th GRADE:

- Must have previous Kindergarten physical on file and be compliant with all immunization requirements.

ENTERING 5th GRADE:

- Sports Physical if planning on participating in sports and compliant with all immunization requirements.

ENTERING 6th GRADE:

- Physical Examination must be completed within one calendar year prior to the date of entry. The exam must include up-to-date immunizations and medical history.
- Proof of one dose of the Tdap vaccine for students entering sixth grade.
- Dental Examination must be performed by a licensed dentist and submitted prior to May 15 of the school year. Dental exams must be completed within 18 months prior to the May 15 deadline.
- All 6th graders must have received one dose of the Meningococcal vaccine after 11 years of age.

ENTERING 7th GRADE:

- Sports Physical if planning on participating in sports and compliant with all immunization requirements.

ENTERING 8th GRADE:

- Sports Physical if planning on participating in sports and compliant with all immunization requirements.
